



AIKEN-AUGUSTA SWIM LEAGUE ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT

The purpose of a code of conduct for athletes is to establish a consistent expectation for ASL athletes' behavior.

By signing this code of conduct, I agree to the following statements:

- I will respect and show courtesy to my teammates and coaches at all times.
- I will demonstrate good sportsmanship at all practices and meets.
- I will set a good example of behavior and work ethic for my younger teammates.
- I will be respectful of my teammates' feelings and personal space. I will not bully other swimmers or exhibit sexist, racist, homophobic, or otherwise inappropriate behavior.
- I will attempt to attend all team meetings and training sessions, unless I am excused by my coach.
- I will show respect for all facilities and other property (including locker rooms) used during practices, competitions, and team activities.
- I will refrain from foul language, violence, behavior deemed dishonest, offensive, or illegal.
- If I disagree with an official's call, I will talk with my coach and not approach the official directly.
- I will obey all USA Swimming rules and codes of conduct.
- I understand that if I violate this Code of Conduct, I will be subject to disciplinary action determined by my coach, the Program Director, or the ASL Board of Directors.
