

Mission

To offer the people of St. Michael the Archangel and Mary Mother of Peace worship experiences that foster a loving relationship with Jesus Christ. We strive for our parish's liturgical prayer life to be reverent, beautiful, and joyful in the Lord.

The revised General Instruction of the Roman Missal notes that since liturgy is the "primary and indispensable source from which the faithful are to derive the true Christian Spirit ... the entire celebration is planned in such a way that it leads to a conscious, active and full participation of the faithful both in body and mind" (No. 17). Since the Liturgy of the Holy Eucharist is the "source and summit" (SC 11) of Christian life, the Liturgy Committee is actively and directly connected and concerned with all of the aspects of the liturgical and sacramental life of the Parish.

The Liturgy Committee's responsibilities are:

To discern the parish's worship/liturgical/prayer needs;

To coordinate the planning and scheduling of the liturgical celebrations for seasonal and special celebrations;

To coordinate, support and evaluate all liturgical ministries in the parish, i.e. readers, extraordinary ministers of the Eucharist, altar servers, lectors, musicians, etc.

To ensure compliance with the liturgical directives, guidelines, norms and policies of the Parish, the Diocese of Wilmington, and the Church Universal.
