WEEK 1 | Luke 24:13-16, 28-32

Easter is the start of a journey, not just a day. Sometimes life feels confusing, and we are not sure what to do next or where we belong. After Jesus rose from the dead, His followers felt the same way. As they walked, hope slowly came alive again. Resurrection means Jesus was dead and is now alive. Because Jesus is alive, you do not have to give up hope. You do not have to have everything figured out. You can take the next step and trust that you are not walking alone. There is a place for you.

5. How can we pray for you?
