1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
2. Jesus washed the feet of people He knew would fail Him and even betray Him. Think about a time when you showed kindness or care to someone who later disappointed you. How did that experience shape the way you protect yourself or hold back today?
3. Jesus served without any guarantee that His love would be returned. In your own life, where do you hesitate to love because you are afraid it will not be noticed, appreciated, or reciprocated?
4. Considering the abundant life Jesus promises, what's one small step you can take today to trust Him more with your next decision and follow Him more closely, even if you don't have all the answers?
