In a world that often feels competitive, hectic, and disconnected, the answer isn't louder voices or more performance. It's something timeless, personal, and deep: genuine love. This isn't just about romantic love but also the kind that strengthens families, bridges gaps, and endures through hardships. What the world needs now is the kind of love Jesus showed and continues to demonstrate today.

BIG IDEA

**God wants to redirect our competitive drive toward love.
That's what's worth showing up for.**

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What is one thing that stood out to you from this week's message?
2. When you think about this past week, what did you show up for most? Not what you meant to show up for, but what actually got your time and energy. What does that tell you about what you value right now?
3. Where do you notice competition showing up in your life? This could be at work, at school, online, in parenting, or even in faith. How might God be inviting you to redirect that energy toward love instead of comparison?
4. The writer of Hebrews encourages people not to walk alone but to stay connected. When life feels busy or heavy, what makes it harder for you to show up for others? What helps you stay connected instead of pulling away?
5. How can we pray for you?

Ask God to help curb your competitive spirit and redirect it toward serving others. Use this prayer to guide you: "God, help me notice when my need to win is getting in the way of love. Show me where I can encourage instead of compare, serve instead of compete."
