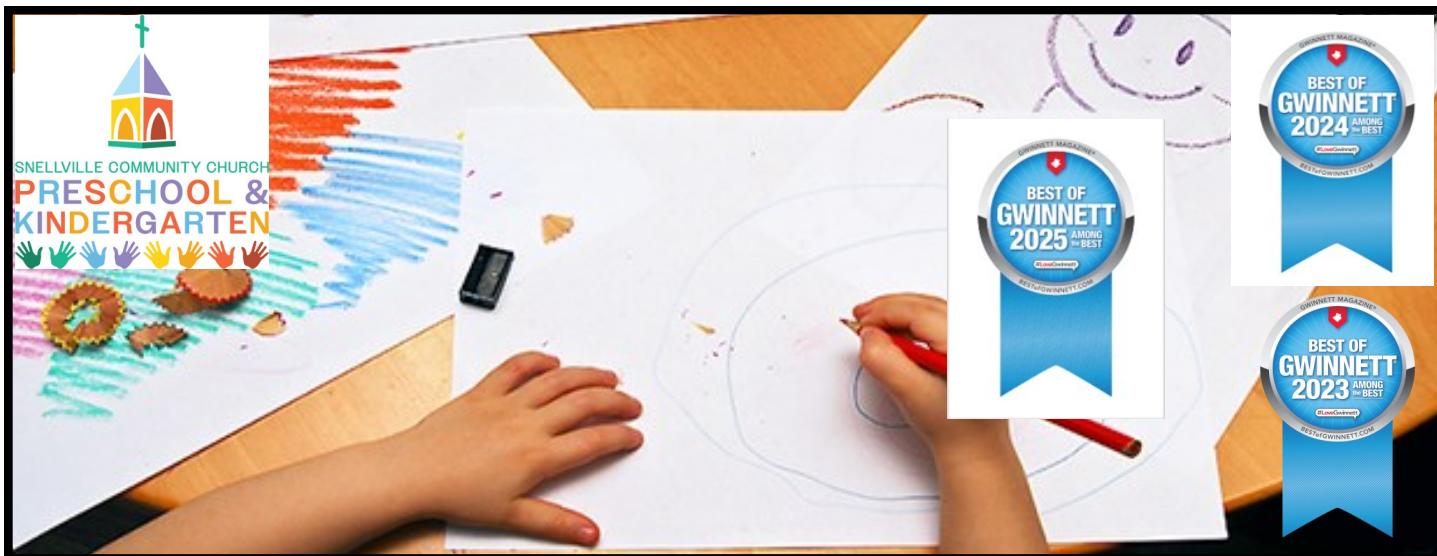

Carpool Information



Arrival for all Children: Morning carpool will be the only drop-off available to families of Two through Kindergarten students. **DO NOT EXIT YOUR CAR FOR ANY REASON.** Teachers will help the child out of the car and to their classroom. Morning carpool begins at 9:25am and ends at 9:40am. Toddler students will need to be walked by parents to the designated door at the end of Building D.

Dismissal begins at 1:25 p.m. All parents will enter the school at the designated door at the end of Building D (the preschool building). **Please bring your carpool tag each day to gain entrance to the building. If you do not have your carpool tag, a photo ID is required for the approved pick up person. The door will be locked at 1:40pm.** If your child is not picked up by 1:40pm, they will wait in the school office until picked up.

We have found over the years, transition from home to school is easier for your child if you make your goodbyes positive, upbeat, and brief. If your child should happen to be upset, we encourage you to ask one of the school office staff to check on your child and telephone you with a report on how he/she is doing after your departure. We are happy to do this for you, as we are all parents and understand how unsettling it can be to leave your child unhappy for any reason.

If you arrive in the morning after carpool has ended, please park and walk to the main Preschool & Kindergarten entrance under the brown canopy. Once at the door, ring the bell located on the panel to the right of the double doors. You will escort your child to the office area where you will sign your child in to school for the day. A staff member will take your child to their classroom.

Please be mindful that arrival and dismissal times are not meant for extended conversations between parents and teachers. In order for our carpool to run smoothly, please be considerate of others dropping off and picking up at the same time.

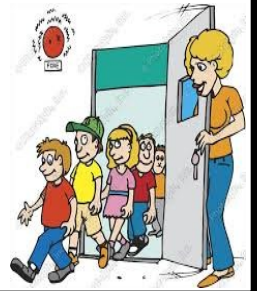
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Safety Drills

The State of Georgia requires all schools to have a school safety plan to address policies and procedures for all disasters—natural or otherwise. The planning for all of our drills is overseen by the Office of Commissioner of Insurance and Safety Fire. I wanted to make you aware of our drills in case you would like to discuss them with your child; emphasizing that all of the drills are for practice. Each month we will conduct a different drill type. We practice: Fire, Tornado, and Lock-Down Drills.

This month we are required to conduct one fire drill which will take place on Tuesday, September 22nd. Please help us by sharing with your children the importance of this process and telling them about the loud noise the alarm will make when it is activated.

Voting will run through the end of the year and you can vote every day. Cast your vote at:

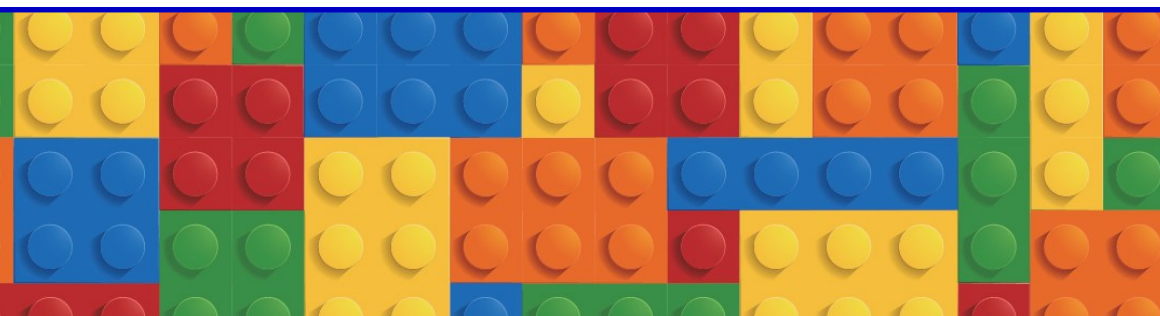

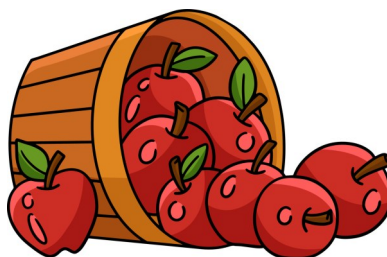
