As possible, please also include this intercession in your Universal Prayer at Mass tomorrow.

Through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Queen of Heaven and Earth, we pray for those areas of the world afflicted by war, especially the Holy Land and Ukraine. May the suffering be comforted, the dead be given eternal rest, those mourning be consoled, and all hostility swiftly cease. We pray to the Lord.
