- Set the stage for discovering and developing the students strengths in utilizing common core standards as a framework for increasing capacity though innovative and empowered thinking and academic mindset
- Legitimize and address how to extend the learning experience of students whose creative potential is emerging through the use of student driven project and service learning projects
- Deliberately integrate strategies that actively support the philosophy that "each student brings something essential to the learning environment that must be regarded and embraced"
- Develop specific practical strategies for engaging and working with students at each developmental level utilizing strategies that strengthen deeper learning
