



Truck Purchase Policy – Final (6/25/2026)

This policy supersedes and replaces all previous versions of the redbox+ Dumpsters Used Truck Policy. Effective immediately, the following Truck Purchase Policy applies to all franchisees.

1. Scope and Definitions

This policy applies to all new and used hook-lift and cable hoist trucks used in the operation of a redbox+ Dumpsters franchise.

For purposes of this policy:

- **New Truck** means a truck that is the current or immediately preceding model year and has not previously been titled, registered, or placed into commercial service.
- **Used Truck** means any truck that does not meet the definition of a New Truck.
- **RBI** means redbox+ International, LLC, acting through its designated representatives.

2. First and Subsequent Trucks

Franchisees must purchase their first truck as a New Truck fully equipped with the complete truck equipment package, including the waste vacuum pump system, through RBI.

Franchisees may purchase subsequent trucks from any provider, with or without the waste vacuum pump system, subject to compliance with this policy and receipt of prior written approval from RBI.

All trucks must present a professional appearance consistent with current redbox+ brand standards, as determined by RBI in its sole discretion.

3. Colors

Grey remains the official redbox+ truck color and the preferred standard for all vehicles. The preferred color is Kenworth Gun Metal (Color Code L0280EY).

New trucks must be grey. New white trucks will not be approved. Used white trucks are acceptable providing they adhere to the following.

a. Used White Trucks

Used white trucks may be considered for approval. Approval will be granted or denied by RBI in its sole discretion based upon the truck's age, condition, appearance, service history, and ability to meet current redbox+ equipment and branding standards.

Approval of one white truck shall not create a precedent or obligation for RBI to approve any other truck.

b. Appearance Standards

Any approved white truck must present a professional appearance consistent with the redbox+ brand.

The vehicle must be free from visible signs of prior ownership or wear that, in RBI's sole discretion, detract from the professional appearance of the vehicle, including but not limited to:

- Decal shadowing
- Paint fade
- Bleed-through from prior graphics
- Mismatched paint
- Excessive dents
- Rust or corrosion
- Other cosmetic deficiencies

Approved white trucks must be painted or manufactured in a standard commercial bright white finish. RBI may reject off-white, cream, ivory, pearl, metallic, or specialty white finishes.

c. Repainting Requirement

If a used white truck does not meet these appearance standards, RBI may require the truck to be repainted as a condition of approval.

In such cases, the truck must be painted Kenworth Gun Metal (L0280EY) and brought into full compliance with current brand standards before being placed into service.

d. Maintenance Standards

All trucks must be maintained in a clean and professional condition. White trucks typically require more frequent washing and detailing than grey trucks to maintain this appearance. This expectation applies regardless of vehicle color.

e. Existing White Trucks

Franchisees currently operating white trucks that do not have documented written approval from RBI must submit those vehicles for review within 30 days of this policy. Continued operation of a white truck shall not be considered evidence of approval. Following review, RBI may require corrective action, including repainting, rebranding, repair, or removal from service until compliance is achieved.

4. STEP 1 – Pre-Purchase Approval

Prior to purchasing any truck, franchisees must obtain written approval from redbox+ Dumpsters or their designated representative.

a. Email requests to support@redboxplus.com using current process and required forms.

b. Provide:

- Make

- Model
 - Year
 - Mileage
 - Engine hours
 - Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR)
 - Hoist make, model, and capacity
- d. Include a minimum of ten photographs, including:
- Front
 - Rear
 - Left side
 - Right side
 - Cab interior
 - Additional close-up and distance photos showing overall condition

5. STEP 2 – Compliance Requirements

Prior to placing the truck into service and within 30 days of purchase:

- a. RBI will determine whether the truck must be painted, wrapped, repaired, or otherwise modified to comply with current brand standards.
- b. Cable hoists must have DOT-approved hooks.
- c. A franchisee's first truck must include a waste vacuum pump and tank package.
- d. All trucks must have a permanent tarp system installed.
- e. Franchisees must ensure all vehicles are legally roadworthy, safe, properly licensed, and capable of passing all applicable DMV, DOT, FMCSA, and other governmental inspections.

6. STEP 3 – Final Approval

Prior to placing a truck into service, the President of redbox+ Dumpsters, or their designated representative, must provide final written approval.

Approval will include review of:

- Vehicle color
- Branding and logos
- Overall condition
- Tarp system
- DOT hooks
- Compliance with all requirements of this policy
- Provide photographs of all four sides of the truck, the tarp system, and DOT hooks.
- Submit requests to support@redboxplus.com

7. Prior Written Approval Required

No truck may be purchased or placed into service without prior written approval from RBI.

- A. This requirement applies to all trucks, including vehicles purchased and/or placed into service without RBI's knowledge or approval.

- b. Franchisees operating such vehicles must immediately disclose them and submit them for review.
- c. Written approval must be obtained before purchase and again before placement into service. The failure to obtain approval shall not be cured solely by later disclosure or submission for review.
- d. Failure to obtain prior written approval may constitute a violation of the Franchise Agreement and may result in notices of default, required cure actions, removal from service, and any other remedies available under the Franchise Agreement.

8. Non-Compliance

The failure to comply with this policy may constitute a default under the Franchise Agreement.

RBI reserves all rights and remedies available under the Franchise Agreement and applicable law, including the right to require repainting, rebranding, repair, removal from service, cure actions, or any other corrective measures deemed necessary to protect the redbox+ brand.

9. Recommended Best Practices

redbox+ Dumpsters strongly encourages:

- a. Extended and aftermarket warranties
- b. Late-model trucks (2016 and newer) with fewer than 200,000 miles or 10,000 hours
- c. Review of maintenance records and a pre-purchase inspection by a certified mechanic
