THE SCHOOL OF EARLY CHILDHOOD

Ages 1.5 to 7

In our School of Early Childhood, we are all about having FUN WITH DANCE! as children explore dance fundamentals with a creative and joyful approach of fun and structure. Enroll in our Early Childhood dance classes and receive a Free Dance Bag with special gifts inside. We have carefully crafted the curriculum using the work of Shana Garling along with DiscoverDance to provide the best in children's dance. Students must meet the age requirement by 9/1/25. Most classes in the School of Early Childhood are Performance Classes as indicated and will have the opportunity to perform.

PERFORMANCES

- Winter Showcase: Mid-year performance celebrating student growth. Early Childhood students wear class uniforms for the Winter Showcase.
- June Show: End-of-season performance at the Appell Center for the Performing Arts. Early Childhood students keep their June show costume.
- Performing classes incur Production Dues. If you do not wish to pay Production Dues, please choose a non-performing class.

Class Recommendations: 1-2 classes per week for skill development, social interaction, and a year-round activity. For Extra Performance Opportunities is the *Forward Company*, open to dancers ages 4-7, just 30 min a week!



The School of Ballet at Dance It Forward sets the stage for the entire school. An American Academy of Ballet Certified School, students receive the finest training from faculty who have specific knowledge of our syllabus, philosophy and legacy. It is both our privilege and our responsibility to joyfully pass on the ballet traditions of classical ballet. Students progress through levels based on mastery of skills. Under our guidance, students learn new positions and movements – repeating and refining them until each becomes part of the body’s muscle memory. Our programs have a proven record of success as our dancers are performing as professionals all over the world. Students use the professional atmosphere in which to grow and as they discover themselves, they are assisted in making career choices whether it be to dance or to explore the many other opportunities available to them in college and beyond. **50% Off Ballet Classes for Boys!**

Early Childhood Ballet

Intro To Ballet (Ages 3–7)

Our ballet training begins as early as age 3. These early childhood classes gently introduce young dancers to the beauty, discipline, and joy of ballet.

- **Discover Ballet** (Ages 3–4) A playful and imaginative introduction to movement, rhythm, and basic ballet concepts.
- **Pre-Primary Ballet** (Ages 4–6) Builds on motor skills and musicality while fostering coordination and a love for dance and classical music.

Primary Dancer Program (Ages 6-8)

- **Primary Ballet** is the final foundational stage before formal ballet levels begin as the children gain readiness for more structured classes.

Young Dancer Ballet Program

Young Dancer Program (Ages 7-10)

- Students typically begin **Level 1A** around age 7 or 8. Once the determination is made that a student has the physical capability to learn technique and the student has the needed intellectual and emotional ability to commit to the program, the dancer begins to progress through the levels. From here, dancers progress through a structured curriculum of **7 ballet levels**, advancing as they increase their skills, strength, and commitment.

* Students are encouraged to gradually increase the number of classes per week as they advance.

* After moving to 1B, continued practice in lower levels is strongly recommended, even as they move up, to deepen understanding and refine technique.

* Mastery of ballet technique comes from consistent, repeated practice of the basics. More classes = faster progress:

For dedicated dancers seeking accelerated progress, we recommend to **FAST TRACK** by immersing in focused ballet training with multiple weekly classes. This intensive option lays a solid foundation for advanced study and performance. The more time a dancer spends in ballet class, the more confident and capable they become.

Progression of the Ballet Levels

PREPARATORY: Level 1A, 1X: Age 7+ Preparatory level classes encompass a warm-up, barre and centre floor. They will be focusing on the fundamental ballet skills and concepts meant to provide a strong foundation on which more advanced levels of instruction will be based.

- Barre work is crucial at this level with emphasis on correct positions, posture, and strengthening of ankles and feet. Dancers should know right from left.
- We suggest adding the Variations class to the schedule in order to learn performance material and be invited to perform in Nutcracker & June Show for those who have not chosen to be members of the Greater York Youth Ballet.
- Prerequisite: Dancers must have completed a year of Primary Ballet or be 7 years old. Taking the Young Dancer Program of the Summer Ballet Intensive is highly encouraged and required of company members.

Level 1B: Advanced Beginner

PRE-PRO Level 2A/2B: Intermediate

Level 3-7: Advanced level class information is available to students with previous training upon request and may be customized. Minimum # of lessons required; Private lessons recommended.

Ballet Technique, Pointe, Variations, Partnering, Private Coaching

The School of Commercial Dance is for ages 7 and offers diverse dance styles in an engaging environment that enhances artistry and athleticism. Students gain confidence that enriches their overall dance education and well-being. Classes are held in a variety of styles including hip hop, jazz, tap, pom/cheer dance team, musical theatre, contemporary and modern dance. Students explore movement while enjoying incredible music in dance classes structured to enhance athleticism that can't be rivaled in any gym. Students also gain confidence that enriches their overall well-being and nourishes their soul.

Performances:

- Winter Showcase or The Hip Nut: Mid-year performance celebrating student growth.
- June Show: End-of-season performance at the Appell Center for the Performing Arts. We work towards the "end of season show" as an exciting goal. Participants often wear their class uniforms and also borrow items as decided upon from our Costume Room. On occasion, students need to supply items such as jeans, a specific colored shirt, etc. This is all listed in the Monthly Newsletters as the show details become available.
- Performing classes incur Production Dues. If you do not wish to pay Production Dues, we suggest you choose a non-performing class.

Class Recommendations:

- For students with no dance experience, a good first class to start would be the "Rotating Class" (a combination of Hip Hop, Contemporary, Jazz and Pom & Cheer), or we suggest trying a Ballet Class (classical music, slower pace at first; builds technique to branch out into any dance area).
- 2 or more classes per week are recommended.
- Hip Hop Crew Performing Company is one of the most popular choices without a lot of time commitment. We also have the NEW Youth Ensemble for elementary aged students who enjoy mostly commercial styles!
- Most classes in the School of Commercial Dance are Performance Classes and will perform in the Winter Showcase or The Hip Nut and the June Show.

Private Lessons & Coaching



- Get the greatest value out of your dance classes by taking private lessons and progress at an accelerated pace
- Work with a specially selected faculty member to improve on flexibility, technique, prepare choreography or work on something specific.
- Private lessons are available at various times throughout the week and on Saturdays; 30 & 60 minute sessions. **24 hr cancellation notice required.**
- \$35/half hour; \$70/hour; semi-private options also available.

- Annual tuition is divided into 11 equal monthly installments (August-June). This guarantees your place in class for the season.
- There are no refunds. This includes tuition, production dues, tickets, membership dues, awards, attire, fundraisers or merchandise.
- Hip Hop & Breakdancing & Adult classes have no discounts and are \$65/month.
- Class scheduling is subject to availability.
- Tuition cannot be transferred or paused.
- Unenroll through the Parent Portal Only by the 15th of the month to be removed from the following month.
- Swap or Drop a Class: No transfers or changes after Production Dues deadlines - Oct 15 (Nutcracker); Nov 1 (Winter) & Jan 15 (Spring).
- Returned Check Fee & Failed Credit Card Fee – \$25.
- Late payment fee of \$20 will be added to your account on the 15th of the month.
- If paying by check, submit in advance by the 25th of the month to avoid your credit card being
- All accounts must have a credit card on file. charged. No Card On File - \$25 monthly Fee.

Makeup Lessons

Our members receive unlimited and our makeup lesson policy is flexible. If a student misses for any reason or classes are cancelled, the student may attend an alternate lesson at no charge, anytime within that season but must be scheduled through the Parent Portal.

Scheduled closings should not be made up as they are already calculated into the annual tuition.

Discounts & Offers

We strive to make our classes high value with no surprise fees, plus offer multiple class discounts to families.

- Family/Multiple Class Discount: Add-on other family members at the \$40/mo rate. Maximum Family Discount \$175.
- Boys: 50% discount; does not discount Summer Programs, Production Dues, Membership Dues, Hip Hop, Breakdancing or Company.
- Bring-A-Friend: Current student earns \$25 account credit for referring a friend who enrolls.

Optional Fundraisers

- The Parents Committee makes available individual fundraisers per season for students to earn credits towards trips, dues, and other dance expenses.
- Details are included in our monthly newsletters.

Need Assistance?

- Work/Study Opps: A limited number of opportunities are available to assist with needed duties.

PRODUCTION DUES

- **Production Dues** cover the cost of creating productions. This includes rehearsal hours, choreography, venue, costumes, rentals, staff, props, set, lighting design & production, music editing, licensing fees.
- Dues are charged per performing class for the School Year Season.
- The system will charge the season's Production Dues in 2 non-refundable installments: \$115 due October 15 and \$115 due January 15.
- No additional costume fees. Early Childhood keeps their June Show costume. Tickets to our performances are separate & extra.
- If you do not wish to pay Production Dues, you may choose a non-performing class.
- Total annual amount charged regardless of when you enroll; non-refundable.
