1. Approval of Minutes

2. Update on 5 hour school day
 - a. A week prior to the meeting Destiny sent the information about the 5 hour school day to members for review.  - c. A parent survey will be sent out towards the end of this school year.
 - d. Counselors, administrators and teachers HIGHLY ENCOURAGE parents and students to attend the yearly CCR meetings. These meetings are a great resource for help planning yearly schedules as well as 4 year plans for HS. The counseling office will also be using YouScience data during CCR meetings to help students identify areas they excel and have interest.
 - e. Concurrent Enrollment, CTE, and AP - MHS offers a wide range of Concurrent Enrollment, CTE, and AP offerings. These offerings are more than other 3A schools in the state.
 - f. PLUS options: MHS has been able to offer Plus options for core subjects (these classes are for students who need extra help and have smaller class sizes and move slower through the requirements).
 - g. Credit Recovery: MHS is now able to offer in person Credit Recovery with a certified teacher. In the past the only option for Credit Recovery was online classes.
 - h. CC members were pleased with the offerings for high achieving students as well as those who may need more one on one instruction and Credit Recovery.
