School Improvement & Academic Data

This is the first year in a decade that growth was observed in 1st grade by the middle of the year.

- Went over all grades reading and math growth from beginning of year to middle of year.
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 - 4th grade also showed increased growth; historically, this grade level often remains stagnant or regresses.
 - 93% of 4th graders are reading at 79–100% accuracy.
 - The school report card is based on the RISE assessment, with a state requirement of 70% proficiency.
 - The school is currently not meeting the state benchmark, due to high standards; however, student reading levels are significantly higher than what is reflected on the report card.
 - Students are reading at a high level, and progress is strong overall.
 - Morgan Elementary received an average rating with a commendable distinction for the school district.
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Literacy & Instructional Programs

- Magnetic Literacy Program is being implemented as a pilot program in the elementary school.
 - The program incorporates writing, reading, and grammar instruction.
 - Student engagement levels reported:
 - Kindergarten: Love
 - 1st Grade: Love
 - 2nd Grade: No love
 - 3rd Grade: Mixed
 - 4th Grade: Love
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Secondary Schools & Articulation

- Both middle schools will participate in a reunification drill to assess safety gaps and adjust plan based on student and staff experiences and needs.
