## Community Council Minutes

1. Review and approve previous meeting minutes
  - a. Nickie made a motion to approve the December meeting minutes. Beth seconded the motion. All were in favor.
2. Training: Utah Data Gateway
  - a. Tara directed us how to access school and state testing data via [Utah Data Gateway](#). This is available for all community members to see. We reviewed MGMS data by grade, in relation to state data and also against our district. MGMS has higher numbers all around.
  - b. It was requested that the school send out reports for individual student data via email or mail so parents have access to their student's data.
3. General MGMS Updates
  - a. Comp guidance survey will soon take place. It is opt-out only. An email was sent to parents if they'd like to opt their student out. The test is taken in advisory. It is to help advise our school's guidance counselor in how to help students succeed and what intervention systems are needed or how existing ones may or may not be working. School is working on adjusting the structure to ensure there is a feedback loop.
  - b. iReady Benchmark testing: going forward they will change the format of how tests are taken, rather than over weeks in advisory it will happen in testing blocks on Fridays. This is intended to prevent burnout from multiple weeks of testing.
4. District Committee Updates
  - a. Policy: Lindsay Budin. Lindsay reported they discussed updates to the district hotline policy which were driven by updates to the state policy on hotline reporting procedure. They also reviewed the new policy regarding the school district's nurses' role as solely an available advisor for kids enrolled in the MHS day care program. The policy clarifies that the kids are not enrolled in the district as students and that it is completely separate from the preschool programs. Both policies will be reviewed again next month before the board approves them in the following meeting.
  - b. Safety: Kelli Atwood. Principal Jarvie reported that they reviewed their safety and reunification plans and reported on a site visit to Ben Lomond which recently

underwent a safety procedure. They will continue to fine tune and dial in their plan to prepare for a trial run during the spring.

5. School LAND Trust and TSSP
  - a. We received 20% more funds from the state. Did not get the funds from the district for the playground structure but it is in the longterm plan.
  - b. Kagan teacher training coming up on teacher workday in February.
