1. Approval of Minutes
 - a. Destiny made a motion to approve the February minutes. Cheryle seconded the motion. All were in favor.

 - a. Cheyla asked questions she has been hearing from community members about registration and transfer students.
 - i. Power School does not have a way for students to pick their own schedule (like they did with Aspire). Registration will work similar to last year with students choosing their classes and Power School auto generating schedules.
 - ii. It is important for students to carefully select classes so that enough sections will be added to the master schedule to accommodate all students.
 - iii. Students who transfer to Morgan will have options for Math/English that will work with the credits they have already earned from their previous school. They will meet with a counselor to decide the best path at MHS.
 - b. MHS offers a large selection of Concurrent Enrollment options for students, including many new offerings for next year.
 - i. MHS was given an award for the largest increase in Concurrent Enrollment offerings of any High School in the State. Thank you to all the teachers and administrators who are working so hard to bring opportunities to MHS students!

3. School Land Trust Plan
 - a. Mr. Thomas presented the updated School Land Trust Plan for 2026-2027
 - i. The plan includes goals in English/Language Arts and Reading, Math and Concurrent Enrollment offerings (specifically in Creative Arts).
 - b. Destiny made a motion to tentatively approve the 2026-2027 School Land Trust Plan as presented with the ability to make changes as necessary. Janelle seconded the motion. All were in favor.
