3. General MGMS Updates

The school guiding coalition will meet this summer to figure out new cell phone rules. The testing cycle is done. 7th grade ELA scores our best ever. Science scores overall high. 5th grade has more areas for growth. 6th grade shows overall strength. Gaps between 3s and 4s show lack of rigor in the subjects. Arts and Letters and Eureka math are both products to improve rigor. Orchestra now available for 6th graders. Not too late to enroll for next year. An additional recess was added for 5th graders. PE is integrated into their skills class. Morgan is scheduled to conduct a reunification drill next week.

4. District Committee Updates

Policy Committee: Extended travel per student remains capped at \$1000. Future requests for increase need to be supported by concrete numbers and presented to the school board.

Sex Ed: New state standards are released. This committee will meet in September to discuss how to implement it. Primarily affects 10th graders.

5. Arts & Letters Program: Jennie Durrant

Integrates reading and writing. iReady data shows the need for improvement in vocabulary. This is the teachers'. Aligns with curriculum and goals to get kids off chromebooks.

School LAND Trust Funds plan approved. Band teacher funds may be FTE funds, in that case, band teacher funds would transfer to stipend amounts for teachers.
