

ORDER
MOVING THE WALLER-HARRIS EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 200
ELECTION FROM NOVEMBER 3, 2026 TO MAY 1, 2027
AS PROVIDED UNDER TEXAS HEALTH & SAFETY CODE, §775.0345(i)

WHEREAS, WALLER-HARRIS EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 200 (the “District”) operates pursuant to Texas Constitution, Article III, § 48-e, and Chapter 775, Texas Health & Safety Code; and

WHEREAS, §775.035(h) of the Texas Health and Safety Code specifies that an Emergency Services District shall hold a general election on an authorized uniform election date as provided under Chapter 41 of the Texas Election Code and may change the uniform election date from one authorized uniform election date to another; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2026, the Board approved by a vote of five (5) to zero (0) to move the District’s November 3, 2026 election to May 1, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED to move the election from November 3, 2026 election to May 1, 2027 for Waller-Harris Emergency Service District No. 200.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Election Day for the May election is May 1, 2027 and voting shall be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m., and 7:00 p.m., at the polling locations reflected in a future election order in coordination with Waller County. The voter registration deadline is April 1, 2027. The deadline for eligible voters to submit an application for ballot by mail is April 20, 2027. Early voting will take place as designated by Waller County.

2. The filing period to receive candidate applications for the May 1, 2027 general election is from January 13 to February 12, 2027 at 5:00 p.m. Applications received prior to January 13, 2027 will not be accepted, pursuant to §144.005(a) of the Texas Election Code.

3. The details regarding the May 2027 election will be set forth in a separate order for the May 2027 election.

4. Under Art. XVI, Sec. 17 of the Texas Constitution, the individuals who currently hold public offices that are scheduled to be on the ballot on the November uniform election date will continue to exercise the duties of those offices until the new officers take their oaths of office, following the May uniform election date.

5. In accordance with all applicable Federal and State law, there shall be provided Spanish, Vietnamese and Chinese translations of the ballot as well as other applicable election materials.

ADOPTED at Open Meeting this the 21st of April 2026 by a vote of 5 to 0.
