

#### A WONDERFUL DAY

"What day is it?" asked Pooh. "It's today," squeaked Piglet. "My favorite day," said Pooh.

There are some people who never seem to be happy with the day given to them. They find a million reasons to grumble and complain. However, the day is a gift, pure and simple. We need to learn to appreciate each day for the gift it is.

I know that is a balancing act for many of us. I, myself, find it hard to be positive all the time. Sometimes, I wake up with my head pounding from a sinus headache or eyes itching horribly from allergies. Sometimes, I wake up and think about the day ahead and dread having to take care of certain matters. Sometimes, our lives can be a real chore.

However, the day, in and of itself, is a gift and we need to embrace it for what it is. I often joke with people when they ask how I am, I tell them that I can't complain because it wouldn't do any good if I did. I tell them I can't complain because I woke up on the right side of the grass. I tell them I can't complain because even though I might think I have it rough, I know others who are facing much worse challenges.

If we could adopt the simple attitude of Pooh by saying "Today is my favorite day", we would be able to see the many blessings that await us. Attitude does determine how much we see or how much we miss.

If we view our day as a favorite day, we would notice the smiles around us, the invitations extended to us, and the love shared with us. If, on the other hand, we view our day negatively, we will miss the positive and key in on all the negative. We will see suspicion, cruelty, and hatred all the while missing the kindness and love surrounding us.

Do you ever wonder if Jesus had bad days? I'm sure He must have. He is as human as you and me. He probably had sore-feet-days and sand-blowing-in-the-eyes-days. Yet, his attitude must have been extremely positive. He must have thought every day was His favorite day because He always met people with love, care, and concern. He noticed the crippled, the blind, the infirm, and the lepers. reached out to them in their need and provided for them as He healed them of their infirmities as well as forgave their sins.

God loves us immensely. He provides for us still to this day. He feeds us in the Eucharist. He forgives our sins. How can today not be our favorite day?



### Gospel Meditation Luke 12:13-21



Recent studies suggest that millennials will be the first generation in America to be worse off than their parents in terms of financial earnings and job status. Many lament this. I propose that this week's Gospel provides a hopeful way to see the trend as good news.

The Lord Jesus says, "Take care to guard against greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist in possessions" (Luke 12:15). Greed damages us with the deception that we are what we possess. But to Jesus, this is simply not true. What makes us happy is who we are, who we become.

Does not the expectation that every generation should do better than their parents subtly mask the poison of greed? A similar attitude is mirrored in the man who demands that Jesus justly arrange his share of the family inheritance. Despite the injustice, Jesus will not play that game. In fact, he seems to prefer that the man have less than his parents.



What good would having more be to this man if he becomes enslaved and miserable by greed? What good would it be for us to have more if it means we become much less?

In allowing the man to have less, Jesus opens a space for him to become more: a man free to love. In that much more meaningful sense, perhaps he was better off than his parents. Maybe the millennials will be, too.

"Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions." Luke 12:15



Did you know St. Thomas More Parish turns 80 this year?!

### A bit of parish history...


On April 20, 1945, Fr. Weis called a meeting for all the Catholics residing in Munster. Seventy-five people attended this meeting, held at a Munster public school on Ridge Road to discuss the possibility of a new parish.

Archbishop Noll answered favorably to a request to start a new church in

Munster and appointed Fr. Robert Weis to make the necessary preparations to establish the church.

Since there was no building yet, the committee petitioned the Town of Munster to either use a public school facility or the Town Hall. Even though the town supported the idea, there was no space available.
