Parts of this tour take place outdoors. Please be prepared for winter weather by wearing a warm coat, hat, and gloves, along with comfortable boots or shoes. Don't forget your camera and your Christmas shopping list.

Three of the four floors in Castle Kilbride are accessible by elevator. The attic and belvedere (cup) spaces are not accessible by elevator. There are 20 steps with sturdy handrails. For patrons that cannot make it to this area, there is a binder with information as well as a monitor that shows a video with verbal tours and

captioning to show and explain what the space looks like.

Dundurn Castle is partially accessible for mobility devices at a maximum of 29 inches wide.
