Day 1: Travel to Alaska

In the morning, fly from Toronto, ON to Anchorage, AK with a connection in Vancouver, BC. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel, freshen up and meet your new travel companions during a welcome dinner.

Stay: Hilton Garden Inn, Anchorage, AK (2 nights)

Day 2: Anchorage Market and City Tour

Spend the morning exploring the vibrant <u>Anchorage Market</u>, where local vendors offer everything from handmade crafts and Alaskan souvenirs to fresh produce and unique snacks. Enjoy time at your leisure to shop, sample local treats, and soak up the lively atmosphere. After lunch (on your own), hop aboard a charming Anchorage trolley for a guided city tour. Sit back and relax as you learn about the city's rich history, cultural landmarks, and scenic highlights. In the evening, enjoy an included dinner

Day 3: Whittier, AK, Cruise Embarkation

After breakfast, take a short drive to Whittier, AK. This small, secluded town, only accessible by land via the 3.2 km Anton Anderson Memorial Tunnel, is nestled between soaring mountain peaks and the Passage Canal. Proceed to the cruise terminal to board your home away from home for the next 7 nights. Be sure to check out what's happening onboard each day, so you don't miss out on something special.

The Norwegian Jade is a stylish and comfortable ship offering a variety of dining options, relaxing lounges, and engaging entertainment. With friendly service and thoughtfully designed spaces, it's the perfect setting for a smooth and enjoyable cruise experience.

Day 4: Hubbard Glacier

Today, marvel at the awe-inspiring Hubbard Glacier, North America's longest tidewater glacier. Nicknamed the "Galloping Glacier" for its rare and dramatic forward movement, Hubbard is one of the few advancing glaciers in the world. As your ship cruises past its towering blue ice walls, listen for the thunderous cracks of calving ice, a powerful reminder of nature's force.

Day 5: Icy Strait Point, AK (7:00am - 6:00pm)

Today, your cruise arrives at Icy Strait Point, a peaceful and culturally rich Alaskan port operated by the Huna Tlingit people. Surrounded by unspoiled wilderness, this charming destination offers a relaxing and authentic experience. Stroll along scenic coastal paths, explore local artisan shops.

Day 6: Juneau, AK (7:00am - 6:00pm)

Welcome to Juneau, Alaska's capital city, a "cosmopolitan outpost in a wilderness setting." Explore fascinating wildlife on an NCL excursion or discover downtown Juneau's landmarks on a self-guided walking tour. Visit historic sites like the State Capitol, the Alaska State Museum, and the famous Red Dog Saloon. Whether you're immersing in nature or culture, Juneau has something for everyone.

Day 7: Skagway, AK (7:00am - 5pm)

Once known as the primary gateway to the Klondike Gold Rush, Skagway, Alaska, is now celebrated as the "Garden City of Alaska" for its pristine beauty. Stroll through the city's historic downtown district, where echoes of gold rush history are still visible.

Day 8: Ketchikan, AK (12pm - 6pm)

Discover Ketchikan, Alaska, "The First City" on the Inside Passage. Known for its salmon fishing, deep-rooted Native American cultures, and gold-rush era history, Ketchikan offers a fascinating mix of nature and heritage.

Day 9: Cruise The Inside Passage

Admire stunning coastlines today as you cruise this world-famous route, taking in breathtaking views of rugged shorelines, lush forests, and towering cliffs. The pristine beauty of the Alaskan wilderness unfolds before you, offering a truly unforgettable experience.

Day 10: Disembarkation, Vancouver City Tour

Wake up in beautiful Vancouver, British Columbia, a dynamic, multicultural city framed by ocean, mountains, and lush coastal rainforest. After breakfast, disembark and board your comfortable motorcoach for a scenic guided city tour. Enjoy views of Vancouver's most iconic sights, including Gastown, the vibrant neighbourhood of Chinatown, and the expansive greenery of Stanley Park with its famous seawall. In the afternoon, set off on a spectacular drive along the Sea-to-Sky Highway, one of Canada's most scenic routes. This breathtaking journey winds past towering peaks, sparkling inlets, and dense evergreen forests, offering unforgettable views at every

turn. Arriving in Whistler, check in to your centrally located hotel, just steps from the village's lively shops, restaurants, and alpine charm. The evening is yours to relax or explore at your own pace.

Day 11: Free Day in Whistler

Enjoy a full free day today, to explore <u>Whistler</u> at your own pace. With so much to see and do, your experienced tour director will be happy to assist you in making the most of your free time. After a day of adventure, gather for an included group dinner and share the highlights of your experiences.

Day 12: Kamloops, BC

After breakfast, get ready for breathtaking scenery as you travel through the spectacular Coast Mountains and the arid Benchlands of the Fraser River on Duffy Lake Road, en route to <u>Historic Hat Creek Ranch</u>. Established in 1861 by a former Hudson's Bay trader, Hat Creek Ranch offers a fascinating glimpse into life during the gold rush. The historic buildings, which stand as they did in the early 1900s, help tell the story of this vibrant era. Stroll along the actual dirt road once travelled by wagon trains, and visit the historic roadhouse, where costumed interpreters will guide you through a step back in time. Afterward, arrive in friendly Kamloops, where you can take in the fresh mountain air with a stroll to the casino for dinner.

Stay: Holiday Inn Express, Kamloops, BC (1 night)

Day 13: Craigellachie, Banff, AB

Today, embark on a journey through some of Canada's most breathtaking natural wonders as you head toward Banff. Along the way, discover tranquil lakes, rushing rivers, glistening glaciers, rugged canyons, and towering mountain peaks. Your route takes you past Craigellachie, the historic site of the Last Spike of the Canadian Pacific Railway, before continuing through the majestic Columbia Mountains into the heart of Glacier National Park. Here, you'll pass through Roger's Pass, famous for its winter snowfall, which can reach an astonishing 10 meters annually! Keep your eyes peeled for some of Canada's most iconic wildlife, with elk and mountain goats likely to make an appearance. After a day of exploration, check in to your hotel, nestled in the heart of downtown Banff, where you can unwind and enjoy the charm of this picturesque town.

Stay: Bow Valley Lodge, Banff, AB (2 nights)

Meals: B, D

Day 14: Columbia Icefields, Lake Louise

This morning, travel to the <u>Columbia Icefields</u>, the largest icefield in the Rockies, for a choose-your-own adventure. Option 1 takes you on a SnoCoach ride across the

vast icefield to the Athabasca Glacier, a massive tongue of ice where you can walk on a glacial river over 1,000 feet deep. Alternatively, experience the Columbia Icefield Skywalk, a new feature offering stunning views of mountain vistas, waterfalls, glaciers, wildlife, and fossils, all accompanied by insightful interpretive storytelling. In the afternoon, the adventure continues to iconic Lake Louise. Then, return to Banff for a free evening to relax and explore at your own pace.

Day 15: Return Home

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight home. As your journey comes to an end, take a moment to reflect on the unforgettable experiences of your Alaska cruise and Canadian Rockies adventure.
