

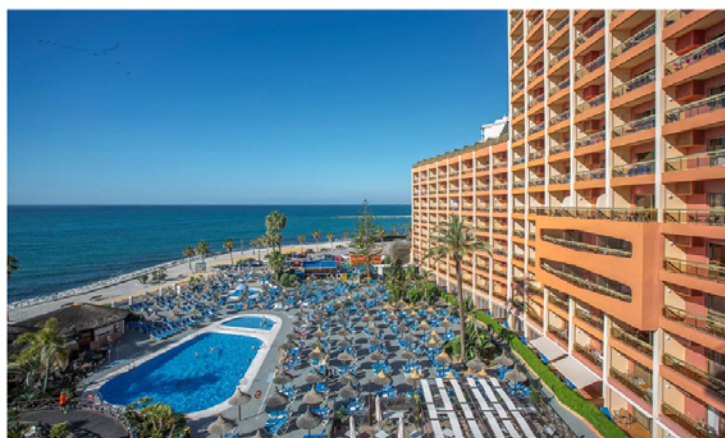

24-hour Hop on/Hop off bus Pass - Included

With twelve stops, one at each main attraction offered by Benalmadena, City Sightseeing offers a unique tour of the town. Tickets are valid for 24hours, so you can use them more than once! Whether you're going to the Marina or for a wander around Paloma Park, this is a great way to get about and discover Benalmadena!

Ronda & Setenil de las Bodegas – Full Day Tour - Included

This full-day tour explores the striking inland towns of Ronda and Setenil de las Bodegas. In Ronda, begin at the Alameda (Mirador de la Serranía) before continuing along the Orson Welles promenade to the historic bullring, dating back to 1572 and considered one of the most important in Spain for its heritage and artistry. The route then leads to the iconic Puente Nuevo, where from the Aldehuela viewpoint you can take in sweeping views of both the 18th-century bridge and the Old Bridge spanning the dramatic El Tajo gorge. After free time in the old town, the journey continues to Setenil de las Bodegas for a walking tour through its unique streets, where whitewashed homes are built directly into massive rock overhangs, creating its famous "hanging houses," before returning to the coast.

Nerja & Frigilana - Half Day Tour - Included

Perched around 300 metres above sea level and enjoying a mild subtropical microclimate, Frigiliana feels like a village suspended in time. Its award-winning historic quarter reflects its rich Moorish heritage, with steep, narrow, winding streets forming a distinctive maze of whitewashed houses and flower-filled corners. The area's deep history is further highlighted nearby at the Caves of Nerja, discovered in 1959 and home to some of the oldest known cave paintings in human history. Free time allows you to explore the caves, village centre, visit local viewpoints, and enjoy nearby highlights such as the famous Balcony of Europe, small museums, and charming churches along the coast.

For additional excursions, a local operator offers day trips and short getaways to nearby cities and attractions.

The Costa del Sol enjoys a mild winter climate, with daytime temperatures often comfortable for sightseeing and outdoor activities. Evenings can be cool, so layered clothing and a light jacket are recommended.

Electrical outlets in Spain use European-style plugs (Type C/F); an adapter is required.

Please note: our Global Long-stays operate differently from our land-based long-stays, as a daily activity program is not offered. The hotel is centrally located, within walking distance of many restaurants and shops. Our on-site representative will be available to offer suggestions.

The Region



The Costa del Sol is Spain's southern Mediterranean coastline, stretching through Andalusia and known for its year-round sunshine, warm climate, and long stretches of sandy beaches. Cities such as Málaga, Marbella, and Benalmádena blend traditional Andalusian character with modern resort life, making the region one of Europe's most popular holiday destinations.

Costa del Sol Beaches & Coastal Landscapes

The Costa del Sol is known for its wide sandy beaches, sheltered coves, and dramatic coastal viewpoints along the Mediterranean Sea. The shoreline is framed by the Sierra de Mijas and surrounding hills, creating a scenic contrast between sea and mountains.

Evenings along the coast are especially memorable, with calm waters, golden sunsets, and occasional dolphin sightings offshore.

- Playa de la Malagueta – Málaga's central city beach, lively and easily accessible
- Playa de la Carihuela – a traditional fishing-area beach in Torremolinos, famous for seafood restaurants
- Playa de Burriana – one of the best-known beaches in Nerja, popular for water sports and beachfront dining
- Cabo Pino & Dunas de Artola – quieter natural beach area near Marbella with protected dunes

Old Towns & Andalusian Streets

Historic centres across the Costa del Sol feature narrow cobbled streets, flower-filled balconies, and lively plazas filled with cafés and tapas bars.

In Málaga's old town, visitors will find bustling squares, restored churches, and cultural landmarks such as the Picasso Museum Málaga and the Moorish fortress the Alcazaba of Málaga.

Evenings bring the plazas to life with outdoor dining, music, and a relaxed Mediterranean atmosphere.

Wine Tasting – Andalusian Flavours

The region around the Costa del Sol is also known for its wine culture, particularly sweet Málaga wines and nearby mountain vineyards. Recommended wine experiences include:

- Wineries in the Málaga Mountains producing Moscatel wines
- Vineyards around Ronda, known for bold reds and dramatic cliffside scenery
- Traditional bodega tours featuring local tapas pairings

Museums & Galleries

The Costa del Sol has a strong cultural offering, especially in Málaga, one of Spain's leading arts cities.

- Picasso Museum Málaga – dedicated to Pablo Picasso, born in Málaga
- Centre Pompidou Málaga – modern and contemporary art exhibitions
- Carmen Thyssen Museum – Spanish art from the 19th century
- Local galleries throughout Marbella and Málaga showcasing contemporary Andalusian artists

Visit Ancient Fortresses & Historic Sites

The region is filled with Moorish castles, Roman ruins, and hillside fortifications offering panoramic coastal views.

- Alcazaba of Málaga – an 11th-century Moorish palace-fortress overlooking the city
- Castillo de Colomares – a unique monument near Benalmádena dedicated to Christopher Columbus
- Gibralfaro Castle – connected to the Alcazaba, offering sweeping views over Málaga and the coastline
- Ronda's Puente Nuevo and historic fortress walls in Ronda

Coastal Walks & Scenic Boardwalks

The Costa del Sol features one of Spain's most scenic coastal walking routes, the Senda Litoral, which connects beaches, promenades, and seaside towns. A particularly beautiful section runs between Benalmádena and Fuengirola, offering:

- Wooden boardwalks over dunes and cliffs
- Views across the Mediterranean Sea
- Access to quiet coves and beach bars along the route

This coastal path provides a relaxed way to experience the region's natural beauty at a slower pace, similar to the boardwalks found in other Mediterranean destinations.

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
