Day-to-Day Itinerary



Day 1: Travel to Drummondville, QC

Board the coach and relax as your journey east begins! Stop in Drummondville for an overnight stay and welcome dinner with your fellow travellers.

Stay: Best Western Drummondville, Drummondville, QC (1 night)

Day 2: Grand Falls Gorge

Continue your journey into New Brunswick. Stop at the Malabear Center to admire the mighty Grand Falls Gorge. This stunning natural wonder, millions of years in the making, was carved by the powerful Saint John River. The force of the water has shaped the gorge into a dramatic, awe-inspiring sight. Take in the views and marvel at the geological history that has formed this impressive landscape. Check in to your overnight hotel and enjoy an included dinner.

Stay: Amsterdam Inn, Florenceville, New Brunswick (1 night)

Day 3: Fredericton City Tour & Free Time (10-day guests arrive)

After breakfast, travel to Fredericton, the capital of New Brunswick. Known for its relaxed charm, the city blends history with modern appeal. Stroll the walkable downtown, where historic buildings meet trendy shops, cafés, and galleries. Enjoy some free time before welcoming the fly-in guests and proceeding on a guided city tour. Your guide will share insights into Fredericton's rich history and notable landmarks. After hotel check in, the evening is yours, to explore local parks, visit more sites, or unwind by the river. Day 4: Confederation Bridge, Kitchen Party, & Acadian Music Village

Cross over the Confederation Bridge, Canada's longest bridge, stretching over 12 kilometres long. Next, arrive in Summerside, a charming town known for its tree-lined streets, elegant heritage homes, historic murals, and picturesque harbourfront, where you'll settle in for the next two nights. This evening, enjoy a delightful dinner and entertainment at the Acadian Musical Village.

Day 5: PEI Preserve Company, Fisherman's Wharf, Green Gables Heritage Place

After breakfast, enjoy a guided walking tour of Charlottetown, exploring its historic charm and learning about the city's key role in the Charlottetown Conference and Canadian Confederation. Then, enjoy a jam tasting at the PEI Preserve Co. followed by lunch at Fisherman's Wharf, a gastronomic treat. In the afternoon, visit the Green Gables Heritage Centre, where you can wander along scenic trails, explore early Victorian life, and see the iconic setting that inspired L. M. Montgomery's beloved Anne of Green Gables. Afterward, return to Summerside, where you'll have the evening free to explore or unwind.

Day 6: Guided tour of Halifax, Halifax Citadel, Garrison Dinner

After breakfast, travel to Nova Scotia via the Wood Islands Ferry, then continue to Halifax, the lively capital, known for its vibrant waterfront and historic architecture. Enjoy a guided city tour to uncover Halifax's rich past. In the evening, travel to the Halifax Citadel National Historic Site, a historic fort that once protected the British from enemies. Learn about life in the late 1800s with a kilted soldier of the 78th Highland Regiment as your guide. End the day with a Garrison Dinner in a beautifully restored room, surrounded by period architecture and fine woodwork.

Day 7: Free day in Halifax, NS

Today is a free day in Halifax. Known for its walkability, Halifax offers a range of activities to suit all interests. Discover the city's museums, such as the Maritime Museum of the Atlantic or the Nova Scotia Museum, dive into its fascinating past at the Halifax Explosion Memorial or stroll along the bustling Waterfront Boardwalk. Explore local restaurants offering fresh seafood and regional cuisine, or shop at unique boutiques and artisan shops. Whether you're seeking history, relaxation, or entertainment, there's something for everyone in this dynamic city.

Day 8: Lunenburg and Peggy's Cove

After breakfast, explore Lunenburg, a UNESCO World Heritage Site known for its rich history and colourful architecture. Enjoy a guided walking tour of this picturesque town, followed by a guided tour of the Fisheries Museum. Afterward, savour a delicious lunch at the Old Fish Factory restaurant. The journey continues along the scenic coastline with a stop in Mahone Bay, famous for its charming views, before arriving at Peggy's Cove, home to its iconic lighthouse. The evening is free for additional exploration and relaxation.

Day 9: Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site

Spend a free day exploring the vibrant port In Baddeck, enjoy a self-guided tour of the Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site, where you can explore the life and achievements of the legendary inventor. Then, enjoy a fun evening with traditional Cape Breton fiddle music, song, and dance provided by The Baddeck Gathering Ceilidhs (if available).

Stay: Auberge Gisele's Inn, Baddeck, NS (2 nights)

Day 10: Cabot Trail

Experience the striking beauty of the Cape Breton Highlands National Park today as you journey along Canada's most scenic and photographed drive, the Cabot Trail. With the expertise of our local guide, you'll receive insightful explanations and stories of the region while enjoying spectacular views of the rugged coastal wilderness.

Meals: B, L, D

Day 11: Hopewell Rocks

Today promises to be unforgettable. After lunch, visit the spectacular Hopewell Rocks, where you'll marvel at dramatic rock formations shaped by the world's highest tides. Continue to Moncton, and check in to your centrally located hotel, just steps from key attractions like the Capitol Theatre, The Tidal Bore, and The Avenir Centre. After settling in, gather with your group for an included dinner. Enjoy a 2.5 hour cruise along Shediac Bay while learning about the lobster fishing industry. Finish this experience off with a delicious lobster dinner.

Day 12: Rivière-du-Loup, QC (10-day guests fly home from Moncton)

This morning, bid farewell to fellow travellers departing for home. Shuttles will be provided for our fly-in guests. For the rest of the group, begin the journey home with a scenic drive from Moncton to Rivière-du-Loup, including a few interesting photo stops along the way. Upon arrival, settle into your cozy hotel accommodations and enjoy an included group dinner.

Day 13: Guided tour of Québec City, Free Evening

After breakfast, enjoy the scenic drive to Québec City, a historic UNESCO World Heritage site, that promises a blend of old-world European charm and vibrant modern culture. Upon arrival, enjoy free time for lunch before embarking on a guided city tour with a local, costumed guide who will bring the city's rich history to life. Then, check in to the historic Hôtel Clarendon, located inside the walls of Old Québec. Inaugurated in 1870, it is the oldest continuously operating hotel in the city, offering a prime location just steps away from the city's many attractions and activities.

Day 14: Free day in Québec City, QC

Having had the guided city tour, after breakfast, relax, shop or explore as you wish on this free day in historic Québec City.
