Day-to-Day Itinerary



Day 1: Travel to Ottawa, Rideau Hall

Board the coach and relax as you travel to the nation's capital. Spring is in the air, and Ottawa comes alive with vibrant colours and fresh energy. Visit [Rideau Hall](#), the official residence of the Governor General of Canada. This 79-acre "urban oasis" has trails, gardens, and historic buildings. (If available, subject to scheduling, there will be a house tour.) While touring the grounds, discover interpretive panels, art, cultural pieces, and some of the more than 150 trees planted by members of the Royal Family and other dignitaries. Check in to the Hilton Lac Leamy and Casino, where you'll receive free slot play and meal vouchers for dinner at the hotel. After settling in, enjoy an evening of fun and relaxation, try your luck at the casino, savour a delicious dinner, or unwind in the vibrant atmosphere of this lakeside resort.

Stay: Hilton Lac Leamy and Casino, Gatineau, QC (3 nights)

Day 2: Visit to the Canadian War Museum or the National Gallery of Canada

In the morning, board the coach for an informative guided tour of Ottawa, taking in the city's highlights while learning about its rich history and landmarks. After the tour, choose between visiting the [Canadian War Museum](#), which showcases Canada's military history, or the [National Gallery of Canada](#), home to an impressive collection of Canadian and international art. Return to your hotel to freshen up before enjoying a free evening.
