Principal's Report. Bryanna V.

Staff returns to building on Monday 18th.

The school is fully staffed. There is a new 4^{th} grade teacher, administrative assistant, morninga 4K aide, and afternoon 4K aide (afternoon aide is also running aftercare). Mr. Multauf is transitioning to teaching 6^{th} grade.

Flood update: Several areas of the school were compromised, mostly due to a leaky roof. Insurance has been responsive and has sent cleaners. There has been no standing sewage and the gym is fine. The teachers lounge and the art room may have to be closed temporarily; art will move to the library if needed.

Back to school forms have been posted online for submission by email. This is new this year.

Back to school picnic is August 21. Discuss creating Sign Up Genius to make sure we have a variety of foods. The school has one grill and could use another, this would be a good "wish list" item.

Back to school night is September 10.

Home and School report. *Rachel B.*

Home and School budget will not include a line item for field trips this year.

High Interest Day is May 1. It is being re-worked to have more options for middle schoolers and activities geared at younger students.

The school has purchased the bounce house that was used last year. Brief discussion of possibly renting it to other schools or churches; need to consult insurance carrier.

New business:

Donut Sunday. School committee is responsible for August 24. Sign-up form will be circulated.

Biergarten. Date is September 13.

Safe and Secure Culture. An expert surveyed the school and gave the following feedback:

Front entrance should be clearly marked

360 degree cameras should be around the outside of the school and monitored.

The camera in the gym cannot be turned on during school days because it is considered a classroom.

The bathroom between 4K and 5K should be able to lock.

Maps of the school need to be updated.

The address of the school and room number should be clearly displayed in each classroom.

Sign-in and sign-out policy for children needs to be enforced; staff cannot simply send students out to waiting cars, parents will have to walk in.

Visitors should wear lanyards rather than stickers.

Marketing:

The archdiocese sent "secret shoppers" to see how responsive the schools have been to new family inquiries. Unclear whether SJS has been included yet or not

A goal for the year is to improve retention of 3K and 4K students by integrating them more into the all-school activites.

Discuss alumni spotlights and making those more visible on social media.

Parent survey needs to be redone and feedback provided.

Fr. Justin wants to emphasize the Catholic Schools Walk, scheduled for October 18th. Discuss soliciting donors to match donations. Consider turning it into a Walk/Run.
