IN MEMORY OF RYAN JUDE DOYLE

A GREETING FROM MIKE

Ryan is the youngest of 12 nephews and nieces in the Doyle family. The distinction of being the youngest makes him the "baby" in the family. Every time he would enter a room, he would be treated according to this honor. We would dote over him as a parent would their youngest. In the constellation of these twelve wonderful souls, Ryan was the brightest of the stars.

On June 16th, 2019, that star seemingly disappeared. Sunshine and happiness were replaced with darkness and sadness. Our "baby" was no longer there for us to hug and laugh with. Life had changed in the worst possible way, and recovery seemed impossible.

In the immediate aftermath of Ryan's passing, I remember feeling nothing but emptiness and despair. The whole experience was nightmarish and surreal. How could Ryan, our baby, be gone?

Amidst this fog, my business partner and great friend, Dana Silva, suggested we set up a fund for Ryan. I remember suggesting this idea to Tim at the reception for Ryan following the funeral Mass. We discussed the possibility of creating a scholarship for a worthy student at the high school. Tim and Dee thought it might be a good idea, but clearly were in no state of mind to discuss further.

Very shortly after, though, Tim and Dee were on board. Dee and Joanna Strange were off organizing the first of six outstanding golf tournaments. Tom Scerbo was providing the experience and guiding light to run a foundation. Steve Lucas designed the iconic RD26 logo. Dee's sister Pam and our brothers, Chris and Brian, were on board, and our MVP, Miss Helen, was out in the community raising awareness and the necessary funding.

Since that time, the Foundation has donated over \$207,000 to families battling cancer and has awarded over \$31,000 in scholarships. We also have adopted a therapy dog, Honeybuns, trained by Kate Tarrant, to visit patients in the hospital.

Though these are the people who started the foundation, it is every single one of you reading this newsletter that allows us to do what we can. You help us honor Ryan's memory every time you make a donation, participate or volunteer at one of our events, wear RD26 apparel or place a RD26 sticker in some faraway location.

To quote David Eagleman, *"There are three deaths. The first is when the body ceases to function. The second is when the body is consigned to the grave. The third is that moment, sometime in the future, when your name is spoken for the last time."*

Thanks to all of you, Ryan's name will continue to be spoken, and we will continue to honor Ryan's memory by helping others for many, many years to come.

2025 COURAGE AWARD PRESENTED

Dylan Pariseau was posthumously recognized as the 2025 recipient of the Ryan Jude Doyle Courage Award by the Western Massachusetts Baseball Hall of Fame.

The Western Massachusetts Baseball Hall of Fame Induction Ceremony took place this past June. This annual event brings together Western Mass baseball legends, enthusiasts, community leaders and former MLB players to celebrate the inductees' accomplishments.

Established by Mike Trombley, this esteemed award recognizes individuals or organizations that demonstrate exceptional courage, strength and a passion for baseball. Dylan, a Minnechaug varsity catcher, volunteered his time to guide younger players and pass along his baseball expertise. Mark Pariseau (Dylan's father) and Sophie Pariseau (Dylan's sister) accepted the award on Dylan's behalf.

The RD26 Foundation was honored to present the award in Dylan's memory. "Dylan wasn't just a good player; he was a good teammate," said Tim Doyle.

HONEYBUNS: THE RD26 THERAPY DOG



Have you seen an energetic, friendly yellow lab at a RD26 Foundation event? Or maybe spotted her smiling face in a group photo? Reintroducing Honeybuns! The RD26 therapy dog. Adopted by Kate and Kent Tarrant, Honeybuns is famous for her loving energy.

Starting at the age of two, Honeybuns began her training at Essential Canine in Wilbraham. She completed both basic obedience and situational training. Her lessons focused on remaining calm and confident around different sounds, environments and experiences. Training continued until Honey-

buns was comfortable and ready to work confidently in a variety of settings. She was certified in November 2023 by an accredited tester of the Alliance of Therapy Dogs (ATD) after many sessions, completing training and evaluations at schools, nursing homes and hospitals.

Since earning her certification, Honeybuns has brought smiles and comfort to countless people. She regularly visits hospitals, nursing homes and addiction recovery centers, and she participates in a read-aloud program. Honeybuns is a certified volunteer at Baystate

Bryce, a class of 2025 graduate, played shortstop for the varsity team. The accolade and scholarship were awarded in May.

The Minnechaug baseball coaches were responsible for selecting the recipient. As previous coaches

of Ryan, they knew his spirit well.

"Bryce had a lot of the same qualities Ryan had. He worked hard and loved the game, but found a great appreciation for just being around his teammates," said Coach Netkovick.

Like Ryan, Bryce "had the ability to lighten the mood and raise team morale just by being present. They both shared strong bonds with their teammates that clearly went beyond baseball."

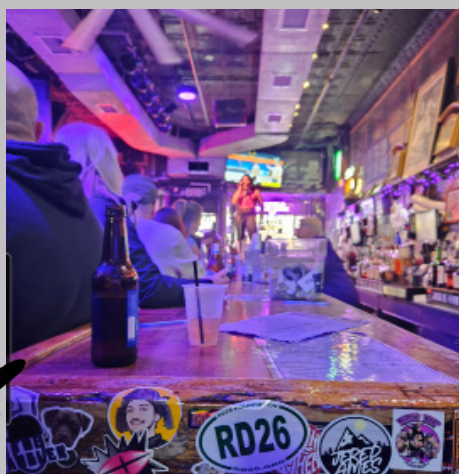

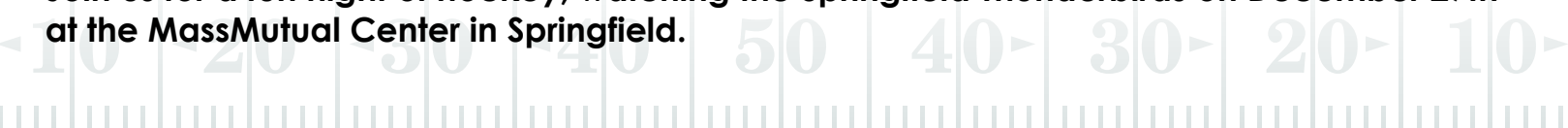
