We expect all our contractors, suppliers, and business partners share our commitment to these high standards and where applicable are able to demonstrate their commitment to anti-slavery an human trafficking prior to entering into a relationship. We believe in fostering transparency and will champion anyone who voices genuine concerns in good faith, even if they may not be correct.

Our commitment to this principle means that any employee who violates this policy will face serious consequences, including potential dismissal for misconduct or gross misconduct.

We reserve the right to terminate our relationship with other individuals and organisations working on our behalf if they breach this.
