Explanatory notes

The following list contains all species that are newly recorded for a 10km grid square within Wiltshire. In this list 'new' refers to records gathered since the early 1980's and the publication of the 1993 Wiltshire Flora. In addition, the word 'recent' refers to this period also.

The information contains both scientific and common names based on the *New Flora of the British Isles 3rd edition. (Stace)*; together with site, brief information where supplied and the initials of the recorder. First County or Vice-county records appear in bold italics. For interest some species may have the IUCN threat criteria attached as documented in *A Vascular Plant Red List for England (BSBI:2014)*.

Acer platanoides (Norway Maple); Chilton Foliat (SU37), seedlings, RAi.

Aethusa cynapium (Fool's Parsley); Chilton Foliat (SU37), two sites, RAi.

Aira praecox (Early Hair-grass); Bowood Pinetum (ST97), common throughout the square on dry sandy areas, MBu & DG.

Alcea rosea (Hollyhock); Hardenhuish, Chippenham (ST97), MBu & DG; Berwick Bassett (SU07), MBu; both at wall to pavement angles.

Alchemilla mollis (Garden Lady's-mantle); Wanborough Plain (SU28), road verge, RAi.

Allium nigrum (Broad-leaved Leek); Holt (ST86), Eleven flowering spikes and growing on roadside verge. Throw-outs now naturalised, DG.

Allium roseum (Rosy Garlic); Murhill (ST76), five colonies over 30m of steep bank. Known here for at least three years, DG. 1st Wiltshire record.

Allium triquetrum (Three-cornered Leek); Bradford-on-Avon (ST85), canal-side, DG.

Anagallis arvensis (Scarlet Pimpernel); Chilton Foliat (SU37); Straight Soley (SU37), both RAi.

Anthemis arvensis (Corn Chamomile) [GB:EN Eng:EN]; Holt (ST86), single plant on landfill site, DG.

Anthriscus caucalis (Bur Chervil); West Kington (ST87), many thousands of plants in a set-aside area of an arable field, DG.

Aphanes australis (Slender Parsley-piert); The Ridge (ST86), common in arable field, DG.

Arabidopsis thaliana (Thale Cress); Cherhill (SU07); Lower End Farm (SU07), both MBu; Liddington (SU28), RAi.

Arabis caucasica (Garden Arabis); Purton (SU08), at several spots, self-seeding into walls and at wall to pavement angles, MBu.

Arctium lappa (Greater Burdock); Chilton Foliat (SU37), two sites, RAi.

Arenaria leptoclados (Slender Sandwort); Peaks Down (SU27), RAi.

Arenaria serpyllifolia (Thyme-leaved Sandwort); New Zealand (SU07); Lyneham (SU07); Beacon Hill (SU07), all MBu; Straight Soley (SU37), RAi.

Arum italicum (Italian Lords-and-Ladies); Clyffe Pypard (SU07), escape from Churchyard, MBu.

Arum italicum ssp. italicum (Italian Lords-and-Ladies); Hardenhuish, Chippenham (ST97), on dumped soil, MBu & DG; Perham Down (SU24), TGCR.

Arum italicum ssp. neglectum (Italian Lords-and-Ladies); Ford (ST87), a population growing at the side of a track, DG. *1st Wiltshire record*.

Atriplex patula (Common Orache); Wittonditch (SU27); Chilton Foliat (SU37); Straight Soley (SU37), all RAi.

Atriplex prostrata (Spear-leaved Orache); Straight Soley (SU37); Crooked Soley (SU37); Chilton Foliat (SU37); all RAi.

Avena fatua (Wild-Oat); Wittonditch (SU27); Peaks Down (SU27), two sites; Chilton Foliat (SU37), all RAi.

Avena sativa (Oat); Kitchen Barrow Hill (SU06), RDu, MGu, PLe, SPi & SS.

Barbarea intermedia (Medium-flowered Winter-cress); Great Wood, Bowood Park (ST96), two plants growing at edge of arable crop, MBu & DG.

Barbarea verna (American Winter-cress); Seend Park Farm (ST96), ten small plants in arable field, DG. Confirmed by Tim Rich.

Berberis thunbergii (Thunberg's Barberry); Stanton St. Quinton (ST98), a single bush within hedge, DG.

Bidens cernua (Nodding Bur-marigold); Bowood Pinetum (ST97), a single plant at the lake overflow, MBu & DG. Last recorded here, by DG, in 1991.

Brassica napus (Rape); Clyffe Pypard (SU07), Growing in verges along Wood Street; Cherhill (SU07) at wall to pavement angle; Cherhill east (SU07), pavement and kerbside weed; New Zealand (SU07) A3102 verge edge; A4 Yatesbury Junction (SU07) road verge weed, All MBu; Wanborough Plain (SU28), roadside verges, RAi.

Bromus hordeaceus ssp. longipedicellatus (Soft-brome); Kitchen Barrow Hill (SU06), RDu, MGu, PLe, SPi & SS. *1st VC7 record.*

Bromus racemosus (Smooth Brome); Chiseldon (SU17); Upper Inglesham (SU29), both RAi.

Calystegia pulchra (Hairy Bindweed); The Ridge (ST86), DG; Garden Trading Estate, Devizes (SU06), MBu.

Campanula latifolia (Giant Bellflower); Red Lodge (SU08), four records totally 47 plants including one that was a refind of Malcolm Storey's record of 24/07/1984. All plants close to water with many enduring dense shade. All MBu.

Campanula persicifolia (Peach-leaved Bellflower); Cherhill (SU07), two sites, wall to pavement angle and kerb edges, both MBu.

Campanula portenschlagiana (Adria Bellflower); Devizes (SU06); Bradenstoke (SU07), both garden walls, both MBu; Great Bedwyn, RAi.

Capsella bursa-pastoris (Shepherd's-purse); Chilton Foliat (SU37), four sites; Straight Soley (SU37); Crooked Soley (SU37), all RAi.

Cardamine bulbifera (Coralroot); Bathford (ST76), at Farleigh Rise near Brown's Folly; over one thousand flowering plants on bank in secondary woodland, DG.

Cardamine hirsuta (Hairy Bitter-cress); Wanborough (SU28), RAi.

Cardamine quinquefolia (Whorled Coralroot); Bradford-on-Avon (ST86), garden arrival, not sown or planted. Two patches of over seventy flowering plants, DG & RHu. Determined by Tim Rich.

1st Wiltshire record.

Carduus nutans (Musk Thistle); Sevenhampton (SU29), RAi; Mill House, Lower Seagry, DG.

Carduus x stangii (C. crispus x nutans); Bradford-on-Avon (ST86) a small population; Bradford-on-Avon east (ST86), over twenty plants occurring with both parents.

These two records represent only the 3rd and 4th recent records but there are only five VC7 records to date with the first by J.D.Grose in 1947!

Carex acuta (Slender Tufted-sedge); Langley Burrell Farm (ST97), plants on upturned root plate; also, one hundred and more spikes at the edge of oxbow by River Avon, MBu & DG.

Carex binervis (Green-ribbed Sedge); Spye Park (ST96), one healthy plant in part of the heath where tree and scrub clearance has taken place, DG. Not flowering but confirmed from vegetative characters by SPi.

Carex divulsa (Grey Sedge); Clyffe Pypard (SU07), MBu.

Carex paniculata (Greater Tussock-sedge); Dodford Farm (ST98), a single plant next to a fishing platform at a private lake, RAi, AA & SFi; Bowood Pinetum (ST97), a single clump on the west side of lake. (Last recorded here by DG in 1984). MBu & DG.

Carex pseudocyperus (Cyperus Sedge); Knoll Farm, Hilperton (ST86); Hill Farm, Semington (ST86), both single plants, both DG.

Carex riparia (Greater Pond-sedge); Upper Inglesham (SU29), RAi.

Catananche caerulea (Blue Cupidone); Hardenhuish, Chippenham (ST97), four plants at wall to pavement angle, MBu & DG. *1*st *Wiltshire record*.

Catapodium rigidum (Fern-grass); Purton (SU08), MBu, Great Wood, Bowood Park (ST96), MBu & DG, Savernake (SU26), WBS.

Centaurea cyanus (Cornflower); Chilton Foliat (SU37), within relic crop of maize field, RAi.

Centaurea montana (Perennial Cornflower); Derry Hill (ST97), several plants on roadside, DG.

Cerastium semidecandrum (Little Mouse-ear); Bowood House (ST97), Many hundreds of plants at the lawns outside the main gate of Bowood House at kerb edges. DG.

Ceratochloa carinata (California Brome); Summerlands Farm, Christian Malford (ST97), ten clumps on disturbed parking area, DG.

Ceratophyllum demersum (Rigid Hornwort); Dodford Farm (ST98), RAi, Aa & SFi.

Chaenorhinum minus (Small Toadflax); Goldborough Farm Meadows north (SU08), DG; Oare (SU16), a few plants at edge of arable field, PD & JBr.

Chenopodium album (Fat-hen); Chilton Foliat (SU37), two sites; Straight Soley (SU37), all RAi.

Chenopodium ficifolium (Fig-leaved Goosefoot); Upper Studley Farm, Swindon (SU18), in a cleared woodland edge, RAi.

Chenopodium giganteum (Tree Spinach); Kellaways (ST97), a single plant at the edge of an arable field, DG. 1st Wiltshire record.

Chenopodium polyspermum (Many-seeded Goosefoot); Wittonditch (SU27), RAi.

Chenopodium rubrum (Red Goosefoot); Crooked Soley (SU37), RAi.

Conyza canadensis (Canadian Fleabane); Chilton Foliat (SU37), RAi.

Conyza floribunda (Bilbao's Fleabane); Sevenhampton (SU29), RAi; Purton (SU08); Wiltshire Golf Club (SU08), within a disused sand bunker; Great Somerford (ST98), hundreds on gravelled hard standing at disused industrial units; Brinkworth Golf Course (SU08) in an unkempt yard, all MBu.

Cornus sanguinea ssp. sanguinea (Dogwood); Westonbirt, Silk Wood (ST88), CL & JOr.

Cosmos bipinnatus (Mexican Aster); New Zealand (SU07), growing atop piles of dumped soil, MBu. 1st *Wiltshire record*. Bushton (SU07), self-sown into accumulated soil at road kerb edge, MBu. 2nd VC7 record.

Cotoneaster simonsii (Himalayan Cotoneaster); Great Somerford (ST98) weed in churchyard, DG.

Crepis capillaris (Smooth Hawk's-beard); Briary Wood, near (SU37); Chilton Foliat (SU37), two sites; Straight Soley (SU37), all RAi.

Crocosmia x crocosmiiflora (Montbretia); Great Wood, Bowood Park (ST96), MBu & DG; White Lodge & Red Lodge (SU08), a small clump near ride in Red Lodge plantation; Red Lodge (SU08), presumed dumped, both MBu.

Cyclamen hederifolium (Sowbread); Purton (SU08), escaped or dumped within footpath adjacent gardens, MBu; Sevenhampton (SU29), garden escape, RAi.

Cynoglossum germanicum (Green Hound's-tongue) [GB:CR Eng:NT]; Rivermead, Swindon (SU18), deliberately introduced onto the 'Tree Mound' Wiltshire Wildlife Trust Rivermead reserve. A 6x6m patch, sometimes dense with outlying plants, RAi. *1st Wiltshire record.*

Cyperus eragrostis (Pale Galingale); Lacock (ST96), Whitehall Garden centre, a single plant growing in pavement crack, DG.

Danthonia decumbens (Heath-grass); Goldborough Farm Meadows, south (SU07), MBu & DG.

Daphne laureola (Spurge-laurel); Liddington (SU28), a single-stemmed plant on shady footpath, RAi.

Datura stramonium (Thorn-apple); Chippenham (ST97), a single plant on recently turned soil at Morrison's car park, DG.

Daucus carota (Wild Carrot); Crooked Soley (SU37); Chilton Foliat (SU37), both RAi.

Daucus carota ssp. carota (Wild Carrot); Greenman's Lane, Dauntsey (ST98), MBu.

Descurainia sophia (Flixweed); Marlborough (SU17), five plants in path edge, MNe. Confirmed by SPi

Doronicum pardalianches (Leopard's-bane); Great Bedwyn (SU26), RAi.

Echinochloa crus-galli (Cockspur); Berwick Bassett (SU07), corner of arable field; Beacon Hill (SU07), at an uncultivated edge of arable field, both MBu.

Echium plantagineum (Purple Viper's-bugloss); (ST86), a single plant, HCr & DG. Determined Helena Crouch. *1st VC7 record.*

Elodea nuttallii (Nuttall's Waterweed); Peckingell (ST97), DG.

Elytrigia repens (Common Couch); Chilton Foliat (SU37), three sites; Straight Soley (SU37); Briary Wood, near (SU37), all RAi.

Epilobium montanum (Broad-leaved Willowherb); Chilton Foliat (SU37), two sites both RAi.

Erigeron acris (Blue Fleabane); Dodford Farm (ST98), on gravel bank, RAi, AA & SFi.

Erigeron karvinskianus (Mexican Fleabane); Hankerton (ST99), MBu.

Erigeron philadelphicus (Robin's-plantain); Frankleigh Farm, derelict market garden (ST86), a single plant, HCr & DG. 1st Wiltshire record.

Erinus alpinus (Fairy Foxglove); Swindon, Moredon (SU18), many established plants high up on a limestone wall, RAi.

Erodium cicutarium (Common Stork's-bill); Five Lanes (ST99), Tetbury Lane, Crudwell (ST99), both MBu.

Eryngium bourgatii (Mediterranean Sea-holly); Bradford-on-Avon (ST86), a single plant at kerb edge. HCr & DG. Identified by HCr and confirmed by Fred Rumsey. *1st Wiltshire record*. On the BSBI database there are only five other records of non-garden or deliberately planted specimens – Ed.

Eryngium giganteum (Tall Eryngo); Hardenhuish, Chippenham (ST97), five plants in kerb cracks and at edge of pavement, MBu & DG. Identified by DG and confirmed by Helena Crouch.

1st Wiltshire record.

Eschscholzia californica (Californian Poppy); Great Somerford (ST98), wall to pavement angle, MBu.

Euphorbia exigua (Dwarf Spurge); Cepen Park, Chippenham (ST97), two sites, one of which had substantial numbers, both DG.

Euphorbia lathyris (Caper Spurge); Lyneham (SU07), MBu.

Euphorbia peplus (Petty Spurge); Chilton Foliat (SU37); Wanborough (SU28), both RAi.

Euphorbia platyphyllos (Broad-leaved Spurge); Dean Farm, Oaksey (ST99), six plants in cropped bean field, MBu.

Euphorbia stricta (Upright Spurge) [GB:LC Eng:DD]; Cherry Orchard Farm (ST86), eight plants along base of hedge, DG.

Euphorbia x pseudovirgata (Twiggy Spurge); Bradford-on-Avon (ST86), a single plant growing at base of a wall in Church St, DG.

Fallopia convolvulus (Black-bindweed); Straight Soley (SU37); Chilton Foliat (SU37), both RAi; Dean Farm, Oaksey (ST99), MBu.

Fallopia japonica (Japanese Knotweed); Berwick Bassett (SU07), MBu.

Foeniculum vulgare (Fennel); Royal Wootton Bassett (SU08), Noremarsh Road; in verge outside school. Known here since 2010 and increasing slowly along perimeter fence; A4 Yatesbury Junction (SU07), a well established plant in roadside verge, both MBu.

Fragaria vesca (Wild Strawberry) [GB:LC Eng:NT]; Straight Soley (SU37), roadside verge, RAi.

Fuchsia magellanica (Fuchsia); Bradford-on-Avon (ST86), A single plant growing out of vertical stonework adjacent to River Avon footbridge was first seen in October 2018 and confirmed May 2019. This plant is the narrow budded pale pink form, DG. *1st VC7 record.*

Fuchsia x hybrida (Hybrid Fuchsia); Red Lodge (SU08), at woodland edge, presumed dumped, MBu. 1st Wiltshire record.

Fumaria muralis (Common Ramping-fumitory); Wroughton, field below A4361 (SU18), matches ssp. boraei. On scraped footpath at top of grazed WWT 'Church Hill Pasture', RAi.

Galanthus nivalis (Snowdrop); Castle Eaton (SU19), in churchyard and approaching footpath; Hannington Church (SU19), inside churchyard gate and perimeter walls; Stanton Fitzwarren (SU19), roadside clumps; Freke Arms, Swanborough (SU19), roadside; Sevenhampton (SU29), roadside; Castle Eaton (SU19), in layby on Hannington to Castle Eaton minor road, all RAi.

Galeopsis bifida (Bifid Hemp-nettle); Coate Water, Swindon (SU18), at draw-down area of large woodland pond, RAi.

Galinsoga quadriradiata (Shaggy Soldier); Great Somerford (ST98), allotments, MBu.

Galium odoratum (Woodruff); Bishop Cannings (SU06), MBu.

Galium palustre ssp. palustre (Common Marsh-bedstraw); Foxham (ST97); Hankerton (ST99), both MBu.

Geranium lucidum (Shining Crane's-bill); Wanborough (SU28); Liddington (SU28), both RAi.

Geranium pusilum (Small-flowered Crane's-bill); Mill House, Lower Seagry (ST98), DG; Sevenhampton (SU29), RAi; Sodom (SU08); Great Somerford (ST98); A4 Yatesbury Junction (SU07); Sandy Furlong Plantation (SU07), hundreds on sandy track; all MBu.

Geranium rotundifolium (Round-leaved Crane's-bill); Mill House, Lower Seagry (ST98), DG.

Glyceria x pedicellata (Hybrid Sweet-grass); Kellaways (ST97), DG.

Gymnadenia conopsea (Chalk Fragrant-orchid); Hardenhuish, Chippenham (ST97), MBu & DG.

Hedera hibernica (Atlantic Ivy); Bell Farm (ST96), WBS; Hardenhuish, Chippenham (ST97), MBu & DG.

Helianthus annuus (Sunflower); New Zealand (SU07), growing atop piles of dumped soil, MBu.

Helianthus tuberosus (Jerusalem Artichoke); Mill House, Lower Seagry (ST98), relic of previous crop; single plant in gateway, DG. *1st VC7 record*.

Helleborus niger (Christmas-rose); Chippenham east (ST97), a single well grown plant within wooded railway embankment, DG.

Helminthotheca echioides (Bristly Oxtongue); Crooked Soley (SU37), RAi.

Hesperis matronalis (Dame's-violet); Sodom (SU08), on roadside verge within previously disturbed soil; Greenman's Lane, Dauntsey (ST98), roadside verge, both MBu.

Hieracium argillaceum (Southern Hawkweed); Bowood Pinetum (ST97), Fifteen plants on wooded bank, MBu & DG.

Hordeum distichon (Two-rowed Barley); Kitchen Barrow Hill (SU06), on track, AA, SFi, VW & PMW.

Hordeum murinum (Wall Barley); Dauntsey Lock (ST98); Hankerton (ST99), both MBu.

Hyacinthoides x massartiana (Hybrid Bluebell); Lower End Farm (SU07), two sites; Royal Wootton Bassett (SU08); Cherhill (SU07); Tetbury Lane, Crudwell (ST99), all MBu; Fresden Farm Verge WCC 1-8 (SU29), RAi.

Hyoscyamus niger (Henbane) [GB:VU Eng:VU]; Kellaways (ST97), over fifty plants growing at edge and within flax crop, DG.

Hypericum androsaemum (Tutsan); Great Somerford, west (ST98), self-sown at wall to pavement angle and likely origin is local garden, MBu.

Hypericum olympicum (Mount Olympus St. John's-wort); Hankerton (ST99), at wall to pavement angle and pavement cracks. Self-sown from adjacent garden, MBu. 1st Wiltshire record.

Hypericum x desetangsii (Des Etangs' St. John's-wort), Upper Studley Farm, Swindon (SU18), in disturbed area around electric sub-station, RAi; Cherhill, Upper Farm (SU06), in an arable reversion field, RAi, JBr, PD & PLe.

Hypochaeris radicata (Cat's-ear); Chilton Foliat (SU37), two sites, RAi.

Inula conyzae (Ploughman's-spikenard); Wanborough Plain (SU28), two sites, RAi; Purton (SU08), MBu.

Juncus conglomeratus (Compact Rush); Briary Wood, near (SU37), RAi.

Kickxia elatine (Sharp-leaved Fluellen); Cepen Park, Chippenham (ST97), substantial numbers in arable field, DG.

Knautia arvensis (Field Scabious); Chilton Foliat (SU37); Straight Soley (SU37), both RAi.

Knautia macedonica (Macedonian Scabious); Frankleigh Farm, derelict market garden (ST86), a single plant on landfill site, HCr & DG. *1*st *Wiltshire record*.

Lactuca serriola (Prickly Lettuce); Chilton Foliat (SU37), RAi.

Lamiastrum galeobdolon ssp. argentatum (Yellow-archangel); Sevenhampton (SU29), at Bellingham Lane, RAi.

Lamiastrum galeobdolon ssp. montanum (Yellow Archangel); Westonbirt Arboretum, Silk Wood (ST88), CL & JOr.

Lathyrus aphaca (Yellow Vetchling) [GB:VU Eng:VU]; Littleton Drew Verge WCC 1-10 (ST88), JPe.

Lathyrus grandiflorus (Two-flowered Everlasting-pea); Woolley, Bradford-on-Avon, (ST86), in alleyway growing against a wall, DG. *1st Wiltshire record*.

Lathyrus latifolius (Broad-leaved Everlasting Pea); Cherhill, Upper Farm (SU06), a single plant midfield of arable reversion with pale-pink flowers. Another patch had pure white flowers, RAi, JBr, PD & PLe.

Lathyrus sylvestris (Narrow-leaved Everlasting-pea); Crofton (SU26), several flowering plants along the edge of the railway near Crofton crossing, JBr.

Lavandula angustifolia (Garden Lavender); Bradford-on-Avon (ST86), at Budbury Close, DG. **1**st **VC7 record**; Bradford-on-Avon (ST86), at Meadowfield [Road], growing in pavement verges, DG. **2**nd **VC7 record**; Purton (SU08), seeded into top of wall, MBu. **3**rd **VC7 record**.

Lemna gibba (Fat Duckweed), Royal Wootton Bassett (SU08), Wilts & Berks Canal, WBS; Summerlands Farm, Christian Malford (ST97), in River Avon above weir, DG; Upper Inglesham (SU29); Horpit, Wanborough (SU28), both RAi; Langley Burrell Farm (ST97), pond in swampy wooded area, MBu & DG.

Leonurus cardiaca (Motherwort); Frankleigh Farm (ST86), very large population with over two hundred flowering spikes. They have spread and seeded across a derelict market garden creating new 'hubs'. Some of the original plants top eight feet high. Originally discovered in November 2018 by DG but unable to identify until July 2019, HCr & DG. 1st VC7 record.

This represents only the second ever VC7 record; the first was in 1946 by J.D.Grose, 'roadside near Old Eagle, Rockley'.

Leycesteria formosa (Himalayan Honeysuckle); Bradenstoke (SU07), bird-sown into roadside cobbles, MBu.

Limnanthes douglasii (Meadow-foam); Kellaways (ST97), a large patch in gateway, DG. 1st Wiltshire record.

Linaria maroccana (Annual Toadflax); Cherhill (SU07), a single flowering plant at wall to pavement angle, MBu. This represents only the second ever VC7 record.

Linum usitatissimum (Flax); Hill Barn Cottages, Bishops Cannings (SU06), hundreds on track; a result of spilt seed from the previous year's harvest, MBu; Sevenhampton (SU29), at edge of maize crop, RAi.

Lithospermum purpureocaeruleum (Purple Gromwell); Swindon, Pearce Close (SU18), garden escape and growing along footpaths near houses, LCh.

Lobularia maritima (Sweet Alison); Hardenhuish, Chippenham (ST97), seeded into pavement crack, MBu & DG.

Lolium multiflorum (Italian Rye-grass); Great Somerford (ST98), DG; Wanborough Plain (SU28), on motorway bridge, RAi.

Lunaria annua (Honesty); Great Bedwyn (SU26), RAi.

Luzula multiflora (Heath Wood-rush); Botleaze and Cottles Woods (ST86), two sites, one of which

had a small population with ssp. congesta in a derelict open quarry, DG; South Wraxhall west of (ST86), DG.

Luzula multiflora ssp. congesta (Heath Wood-rush); Botleaze and Cottles Wood (ST86), a small population of this subspecies with L. multiflora in a derelict open quarry, DG.

Lycium barbarum (Duke of Argyll's Tea-plant); Foxham Locks, Foxham (ST97), suckers or self-sown seedlings at edge of grass verge. Parent plants in garden behind, MBu.

Malcolmia maritima (Virginia Stock); Cherhill (SU07), at the wall to pavement angle, MBu. Surprisingly I feel, this represents only the second VC7 record; the first was at Spye Estate (ST96) in June 2015 by Tom Cairns. There are no records for VC8 – Ed.

Malva moschata (Musk-mallow); Straight Soley (SU37); Crooked Soley (SU37), RAi.

Malva neglecta (Dwarf Mallow); Lower Greenhill Farm (SU08), in gravelled edge to tarmac drive; New Zealand (SU07), within mown area of grass open space, both MBu.

Malva x clementii (Garden Tree-mallow); South Wraxhall, west of (ST86), two sites. A total of four plants on dumped soil within a derelict area, both DG. 1st Wiltshire record.

Melilotus altissimus (Tall Melilot); Summerlands Farm, Christian Malford (ST97), DG; Langley Burrell Farm (ST97), MBu & DG.

Melilotus indicus (Small Melilot); Holt (ST86), a single plant on landfill site, DG. *1st VC7 record.* There have been only three other records for this species; 1909, 1940 and 1959. – Ed.

Mentha x verticillata (Whorled Mint); Savernake (SU26), large hybrid swarm, WBS.

Mentha x villosa (Apple-mint); Dauntsey Lock (ST98), covering twenty-five square metres of road verge, MBu.

Myosotis laxa (Tufted Forget-me-not); Pond Close Farm, Gastard (ST86); Hill Farm, Semington (ST86), both DG.

Myosotis ramosissima (Early Forget-me-not); Chilton Foliat (SU37), in roadside grass at garden entrance in village, RAi.

Myosotis secunda (Creeping Forget-me-not); Goldborough Farm Meadows SSSI north (SU07), two sites in an overgrown pond, both MBu & DG.

Myosotis sylvatica (Wood Forget-me-not); Liddington (SU28), RAi.

Myosurus minimus (Mousetail) [GB:VU Eng:VU]; Wanborough (SU28), dozens of plants in muddy field gateway RAi.

This only the third recent VC7 record and only the ninth since 1888! – Ed.

Myriophyllum aquaticum (Parrot's-feather); Snell's Farm (SU08), at a recently excavated, private, small lake; a small patch regenerating, MBu.

Nassella tenuissima (Argentine Needle-grass); Purton (SU08), self-sown into kerb edges from adjacent garden, MBu. *1st Wiltshire record.*

Nigella damascena (Love-in-a mist); Chippenham east (ST97), pavement cracks, DG.

Nitella mucronata (Pointed Stonewort); Cotswold Water Park Lake 41 (SU09); CWP Lake 77 (SU09), both SPi.

Nuphar lutea (Yellow Water-lily); Sevenhampton (SU29), River Cole; Upper Inglesham (SU29), River Cole, both RAi.

Odontites vernus (Red Bartsia); Chilton Foliat (SU37), three sites; Straight Soley (SU37); Balaam's Wood (SU37); Briary Wood, near (SU37); Crooked Soley (SU37), all RAi.

Oenothera glazioviana (Large-flowered Evening-primrose); Great Somerford (ST98), MBu.

Onopordum acanthium (Cotton Thistle); Snake's Lane Plantation, Yatesbury (SU07), at a farmer's rubbish dump, MBu.

Origanum vulgare (Wild Marjoram); Wanborough Plain (SU28), roadside verge, RAi.

Ornithogalum umbellatum ssp. campestre (Star-of-Bethlehem); Weaver's Bridge (ST96), previously discovered in this location when only in leaf in 2016, DG.

Ornithopus perpusillus (Bird's-foot); Bowood Pinetum (ST97), six plants growing at base of tree that had been previously herbicided allowing annuals to occur, MBu & DG.

Orobanche elatior (Knapweed Broomrape); Kingsdown (ST86), two spikes in rough calcareous grassland, DG.

Oxalis corniculata (Procumbent Yellow-sorrel); Swindon, Gorse Hill (SU18); Chilton Foliat (SU37); Common Platt (SU18), all RAi; Great Somerford (ST98), JBe, MBu, PLe & SPi; Great Somerford, west (ST98), MBu.

Oxalis exilis (Least Yellow-sorrel); Royal Wootton Bassett (SU08), two sites; Waite Hill Farm (SU08); all MBu.

Papaver dubium (Long-headed Poppy); Hankerton (ST99); Purton (SU08); Great Somerford, west (SU08), all MBu.

Parietaria judaica (Pellitory-of-the-wall); Bradenstoke (SU07); Purton (SU08), two sites; Royal Wootton Bassett (SU08); Cherhill (SU07), all MBu.

Paris quadrifolia (Herb-Paris); Wansdyke Farm, Calne (SU06), two sites in Blackland Wood, with one an assumed updated grid reference of M.Tyte's record of 27/07/1987, both MBu.

Parthenocissus inserta (False Virginia-creeper); Chittoe Heath (ST96), a single young plant in market garden, WBS. *1st VC7 record.*

Pentaglottis sempervirens (Green Alkanet); Great Somerford, west (ST98); Great Somerford (ST98), both MBu; Great Somerford (ST98), DG; Great Somerford (ST98), JBe, MBu, PLe & SPi.

Persicaria bistorta (Common Bistort); Great Somerford, River Avon (ST98), a single flowering plant on river bank, JBe, MBu, PLe & SPi.

Persicaria hydropiper (Water-pepper); Sevenhampton (SU29), River Cole bank, RAi.

Persicaria lapathifolia (Pale Persicaria); Chilton Foliat (SU37), RAi.

Petroselinum segetum (Corn Parsley); A4 protected road verge (SU26) a single plant at verge edge, JBr & PD; Great Bedwyn Junction east of Marlborough verge WCC 2-31 (SU26), JBr; Summerlands Farm, Christian Malford (ST97), very large population stretching for 50m along boundary hedge with track; Kingston St. Michael (ST97), on an old hedge bank for several metres, PWn.

Phalaris canariensis (Canary-grass); Roundway Hill, Devizes (SU06), a single plant in the centre of a stone track, MBu.

Pilosella aurantiaca (Fox-and-cubs); Badbury (SU18), RAi.

Poa angustifolia (Narrow-leaved Meadow-grass); Peatmoor, Swindon (SU18), Peatmoor Community Hall, block-paved car park; Littleton Drew Verge WCC 1-10 (ST88), a few plants, both RAi.

Poa humilis (Spreading Meadow-grass); Spye Park (ST96), in acid grassland, SPi.

Polygonum arenastrum (Equal-leaved Knotgrass); Chilton Foliat (SU37), Briary Wood, near (SU37); Crooked Soley (SU37), all RAi.

Polygonum rurivagum (Cornfield Knotgrass); New Zealand (SU07), a single plant at an uncultivated edge of an arable field, MBu.

Polystichum aculeatum (Hard Shield-fern); Liddington (SU28); Peatmoor Copse, (SU18), a single plant, ditch side with several P.setiferum, both RAi.

Potamogeton berchtoldii (Small Pondweed); Little Ashley (ST86), frequent in ornamental lake at golf course, DG; Dodford Farm (ST98), pond, RAi, AA & SFi.

Potamogeton pectinatus (Fennel Pondweed); Bowood Pinetum (ST97), in Bowood lake, MBu & DG; Great Somerford: River Avon, JBe, MBu, PLe & SPi; Kellaways (ST97), DG.

Potentilla reptans (Creeping Cinquefoil); Chilton Foliat (SU37); Straight Soley (SU37), both RAi.

Potentilla x mixta (Hybrid Cinquefoil); Foxham Locks, Foxham (ST97), MBu; Chippenham east (ST97) occurring at edge of old railway line; Peckingell (ST97), large population on bank, both DG; Bowood Pinetum (ST97), MBu & DG.

Poterium sanguisorba ssp. balearicum (Fodder Burnet); Peatmoor Copse (SU18), a single plant in bare soil near stream; Barnfield, Swindon (SU18), a single plant on roadside bank and waste ground near B&Q Superstore, both Rai

Primula x polyantha (False Oxlip); Cherhill (SU07), both parents in the vicinity, MBu.

Prunus x fruticans (P.domestica x spinosa); Hinton Marsh Farm, Wanborough (SU28), RAi.

Quercus rubra (Red Oak); Derry Hill (ST97), extensively planted in woodland but occurring in many sizes indicating regeneration, DG.

Brunnera macrophylla (Great Forget-me-not); Iford (ST75), two clumps; one obviously expanding along bank; Iford (ST85), two clumps; one obviously expanding along bank, both DG.

Calendula officinalis (Pot Marigold); Amesbury (SU14), in disturbed roadside ground, AA & SFi.

Callitriche obtusangula (Blunt-fruited Water-starwort); Gould's Farm, Donhead St. Andrew (ST92), in river, AA, SFi & VW.

Callitriche platycarpa (Various-leaved Water-starwort); Knook (ST94), in River Wylye; Fonthill (ST93), south-east end of lake, both AA, SFi & VW; Donhead St. Mary (ST92), at Mullin's Bridge, AA & SFi.

Reseda lutea (Wild Mignonette); Rivar Down (SU36), two sites, both RAi.

Reseda luteola (Weld); Shalbourne (SU36), RAi.

Rhus typhina (Stag's-horn Sumach); Heytesbury (ST94), suckering on verge in the town, AA, SFi & VW; Studley Green, Trowbridge (ST85), an expanding population growing with large patch of Lamium maculatum, DG.

Rorippa amphibia (Great Yellow-cress); Churchfields, Salisbury (SU12), three sites, widespread in each, DG.

Rosa sherardii (Sherard's Downy-rose); SPTA: Coulston (ST95), WBS.

Rosa stylosa (Short-styled Field-rose); Ansty Down (ST92), AA, SFi & VW.

Rumex acetosella (Sheep's-sorrel); Shalbourne (SU36), RAi.

Rumex hydrolapathum (Water Dock); Gould's Farm, Donhead St. Andrew (ST92), in river, AA, SFi & VW.

Ruscus aculeatus (Butcher's-broom); Bishopstrow (ST84), in churchyard, AA & SFi; All Cannings North (SU06), planted as hedge but suckering out into bridleway, MBu.

Sagina apetala (Annual Pearlwort); Bishopstrow (ST84), AA & SFi.

Salix pentandra (Bay Willow); Kinghay (ST82), beside pond, AA & SFi.

Salix viminalis (Osier); Sedgehill (ST82), AA & SFi.

Salix x fragilis (Hybrid Crack-willow); Kinghay (ST82), AA & SFi.

Salix x reichardtii (S. caprea x cinerea); Redlynch Pimlico Field 8 (SU21), present on old hedge line, AA, SFi, AM & KAT.

Salix x smithiana (S. viminalis x caprea); Manor Farm, All Cannings (SU06), MBu.

Sasa palmata (Broad-leaved Bamboo); Fonthill (ST93), naturalised in wet woodland, AA, SFi & VW. 1st VC8 record.

Sedum acre (Biting Stonecrop), SPTA: Battlesbury Hill (ST84), PLe.

Sedum album (White Stonecrop); Bishopstrow (ST84), AA & SFi; Charlton St. Peter (SU15), DG.

Sedum forsterianum (Rock Stonecrop); Upton Lovell (ST94), in churchyard, SFi.

Sedum spurium (Caucasian-stonecrop); Whiteparish Common & Cowesfield Wood verges WCC 2-13 (SU22), at Parkwater Road, PMW; Ludwell (ST92), AA, SFi & VW.

Senecio aquaticus (Marsh Ragwort); Knook (ST94), AA, SFi & VW.

Senecio squalidus (Oxford Ragwort); Amesbury (SU14), AA & SFi.

Setaria pumila (Yellow Bristle-grass); Manor Farm, Collingbourne Kingston (SU25), abundant at edge of maize field, WBS.

Setaria viridis (Green Bristle-grass); Semley (ST82), AA & SFi.

Sinapis alba (White Mustard); Upper Pertwood (ST83), two sites; Keysley Down (ST83); Sutton Veny (ST84), all SFi; Hilperton (ST85), DG; Amesbury (SU14), two sites, both AA & SFi.

Sison amonum (Stone Parsley); Little Langford (SU03), growing along a fence line in layby of the A36. Known by the recorder for twenty-five years and more, DG; Fonthill Gifford, (ST93), WBS.

Solanum lycopersicum (Tomato); Upper Pertwood (ST83), on muckheap, SFi; Larkhill (SU14) at field edge, AA & SFi.

Solanum nigrum (Black Nightshade); Lower Zeals & Wolverton (ST73), PLe.

Solidago canadensis (Canadian Goldenrod); Sherrington (ST93), AA & SFi.

Solidago gigantea (Early Goldenrod); Whiteparish (SU22), abandoned land off Common Road, PMW.

Sparganium emersum (Unbranched Bur-reed); Bishopstrow (ST84), two sites, both River Wylye, both AA & SFi.

Spergula arvensis (Corn Spurrey) [GB:VU Eng:VU]; East Knoyle (ST83), two sites, both on and near paths, AA & SFi; Fonthill Gifford (ST93), locally abundant, WBS.

Stachys arvensis (Field Woundwort) [GB:NT Eng:NT]; Semley (ST82), in maize field, AA & SFi.

Stellaria neglecta (Greater Chickweed); Gutch Common: Crates Wood (ST82), in full flower on road verge; Semley Hill Woods WWT Reserve: (ST82), in flower on woodland floor; Semley Hill Woods WWT Reserve: (ST82), numerous plants in flower on road verge and edge of wood; Shaftesbury (Hatts Farm) (ST82), many plants flowering on lane bank, Semley Hill (ST82), road verge, all SPi.

Symphoricarpos x chenaultii (Pink Snowberry); North Bradley (ST85), large colony on dumped soil in disused greenway, HCr & DG.

Symphytum grandiflorum (Creeping Comfrey); Kinghay (ST82), naturalised widely on verge, AA & SFi.

Symphytum orientale (White Comfrey); Stourhead (ST73), at roadside, DG.

Symphytum tuberosum (Tuberous Comfrey); Norrington (ST92); Tollard Green (ST91); Alvediston (ST92), all SJJ.

Tanacetum parthenium (Feverfew); Heytesbury (ST94), AA, SFi & VW.

Tanacetum vulgare (Tansy); Amesbury (SU14), AA &SFi; Franchises Lodge, Pylon Track (SU21), AA, SFi & PMW.

Taraxacum oxoniense; Perham Down (SU257499), TGCR. 1st Wiltshire record.

Thalictrum flavum (Common Meadow-rue); Shrewton (SU04), on road verge, AA & SFi.

Thesium humifusum (Bastard-toadflax); SPTA: Sidbury Hill NE (SU25), several plants on near bare track, JRM.

Thlaspi arvense (Field Penny-cress); Cley Hill north (ST84), DG.

Thuja plicata (Western Red-cedar); Franchises Wood (SU21), two sites, both with planted trees but with self-sown seedlings present, WBS.

Torilis nodosa (Knotted Hedge-parsley); Amesbury (SU14), four sites, all in disturbed ground. One, in untended verge near fence with plants 20m apart with lots of Papaver sp, all AA & SFi.

Trachystemon orientalis (Abraham-Isaac-Jacob); Patney Bridge (SU05); several clumps in scrub totalling fifty square metres, MBu; Donhead St. Andrew (ST92), naturalised escape, AA & SFi.

Trifolium fragiferum (Strawberry Clover) [GB:LC Eng:VU]; Ruddlebats Hanging, Stert (SU05), two sites, one a railway bank, both DG.

Trifolium hybridum (Alsike Clover); Peckons Hill (ST92), AA, SFi & VW; Whiteparish, Bushy Copse (SU22); PMW; Coulston: Barn Bottom (ST95), SPi & WBS.

Trifolium medium (Zigzag Clover); Wilton Brail (SU26), RAi.

Triticum aestivum (Bread Wheat); Parsonage Down NNR (SU04), two sites, both volunteers, AA, SFi & VW; Sutton Veny (ST83) on track side; Sutton Veny (ST84), both SFi.

Typha angustifolia (Lesser Bulrush) Teffont Common (ST93), in fishing pond, SFi.

Urtica urens (Small Nettle); Rivar Down (SU36), RAi.

Valerianella locusta (Common Cornsalad), Gould's Farm, Donhead St. Andrew (ST92), in garden, AA, SFi & VW.

Verbascum densiflorum (Dense-flowered Mullein); Salisbury (SU13), volunteer in garden, SFi.

Verbascum virgatum (Twiggy Mullein); SPTA: Dumbell Copse (SU14), a one metre tall plant on outer south-west corner of copse. Distinctive sessile individual florets growing up fairly, slender stem. Cannot be a garden escape in this isolated location 2km from nearest house. JRM.

Verbena bonariensis (Argentinian Vervain); Studley Green, Trowbridge (ST85), DG.

Verbena officinalis (Vervain); Monk's Arundell Coppice (ST91), RW; Teffont Common, SFi; Burbage (SU26), a single plant at the edge of a stubble field, RAi.

Veronica agrestis (Green Field-speedwell); SPTA: West Hill, east of Everleigh (SU25), JRM; Monkton Deverill (ST83), Keysley Farm (ST83), three sites; Keysley Down (ST84), two sites, all SFi.

Veronica arvensis (Wall Speedwell); Semley (ST82), two sites, both Aa & SFi.

Veronica crista-galli (Crested Field-speedwell); Staples Hill, Freshford (ST792594), many hundreds of plants on newly cleared garden bank and, also on footpath, DG. *1st VC8 record.*

Veronica officinalis (Heath Speedwell) [GB:LC Eng:NT]; SPTA (West), a single plant, PSk.

Veronica polita (Grey Field-speedwell); Stert (SU05), SPi; Patney Bridge (SU05), MBu; Beechingstoke (SU05), DG.

Viburnum lantana (Wayfaring-tree); Kinghay (ST82), AA & SFi.

Vicia sativa ssp. nigra (Common Vetch); Redlynch, Pimlico Field 7(SU21), JBr, PD & VW.

Vicia sativa ssp. segetalis (Common Vetch); Hindon (ST83); East Knoyle (ST83), three sites; Sutton Veny (ST84); Bishopstrow (ST84), two sites; all AA & SFi; Sutton Veny (ST83); Sutton Veny (ST84); Willoughby Hedge (ST83), all SFi; Shermel Gate (ST91), RW.

Vicia tetrasperma (Smooth Tare), SPTA: Ablington Down (SU14), SPi.

Vinca major (Greater Periwinkle); Heytesbury (ST94); Knook (ST84), both AA, SFi & VW.

Viola arvensis (Field Pansy); Lower Zeals & Wolverton (ST73), PLe.

Viola riviniana (Common Dog-violet); Sutton Veny (ST94), AA & SFi; Norton Bavant (ST94), SFi; Heytesbury (ST94), AA, SFi & VW.

Viola x bavarica (V. reichenbachiana x riviniana); Monkton Deverill (ST83), still in flower, dark spur with groove at 21st June, SFi.

Vulpia bromoides (Squirreltail Fescue); Perham Down (SU24), TGCR; Porton, north-west of (SU13), RBr & LSa.

Vulpia myuros (Rat's-tail Fescue); Peckons Hill (ST92), AA, SFi & VW.
