How Curbside Recycling Works

- Collection: Residents mix all acceptable recyclables in a single container and place it at the curb. Rumpke collects the mixed recycling in a single truck. The recyclables are taken to Rumpke's regional recycling facility in Columbus for sorting and processing.
- Sorting & Processing: The process of collecting mixed recycling and then sorting the items by type is called single stream recycling. Rumpke's Columbus Recycling Facility uses advanced technology, including optical scanners and electromagnets, to sort recyclables by type. It is one of the country's most technologically advanced recycling systems.
- 3 End-Users: Once sorted, the recyclables are compressed into large bales, which are transported to manufacturers (e.g. end-users). Rumpke works with a network of manufacturers to turn your material into new products.
