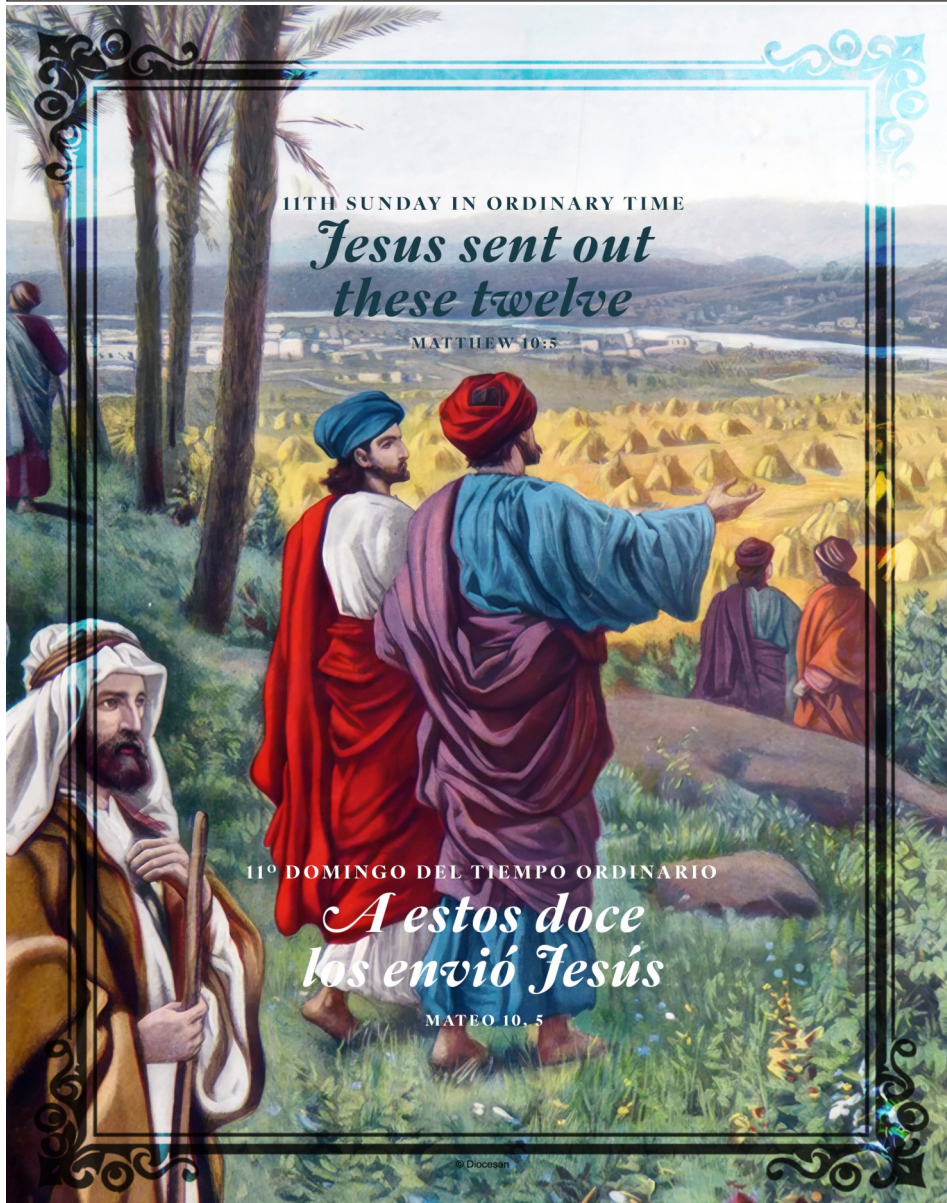

Dear Friends,

Seven year old David loved spending fun time with his Grandpa. One day he started asking all sorts of questions. "Grandpa, what happens when you die?" Grandpa was only in his early fifties and had not done a whole lot of thinking about dying. 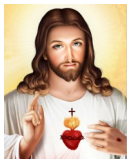
