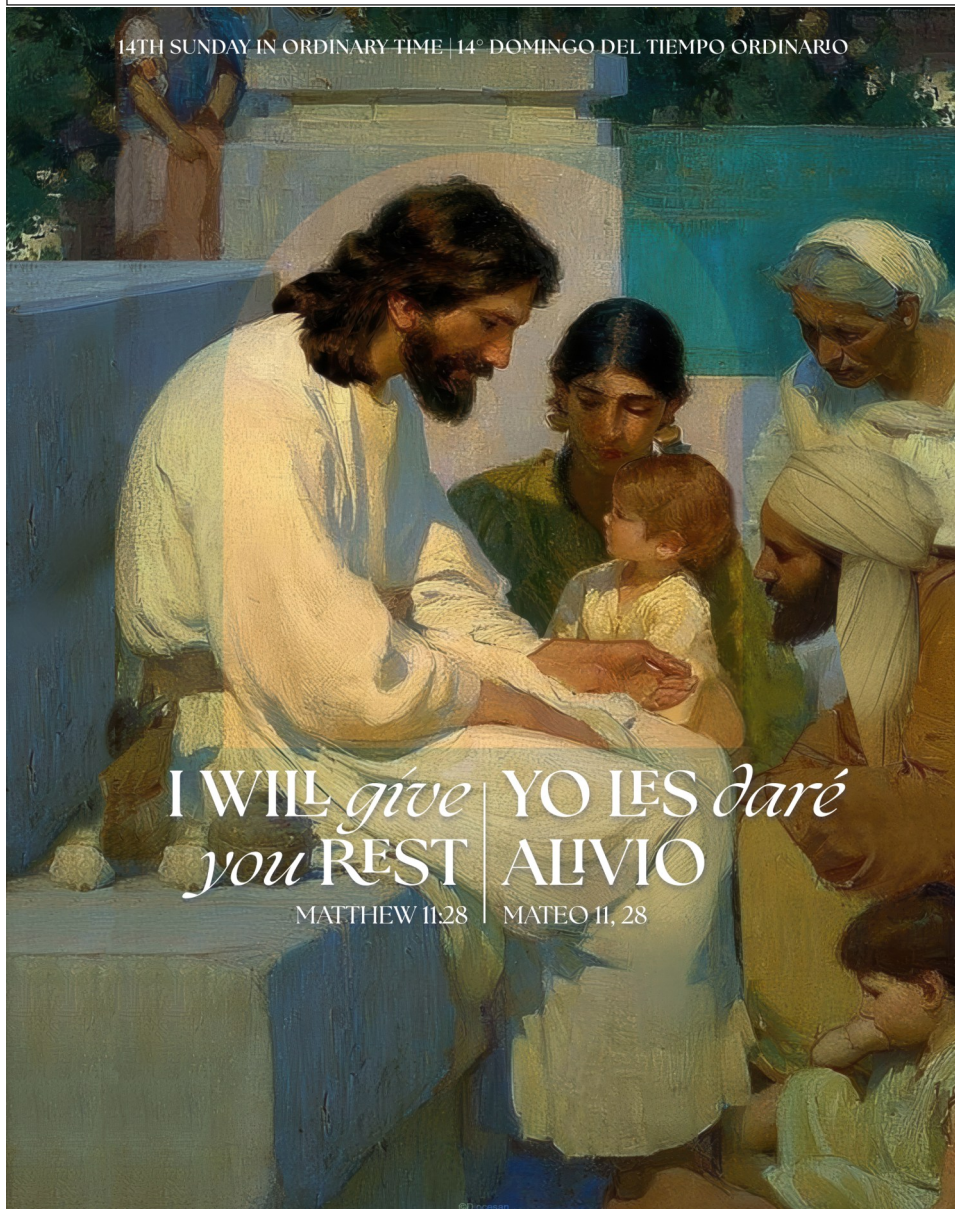

Dear Parishioners,

As we celebrate the Fourth of July weekend, we give thanks to God for the many blessings we enjoy as a nation. As Christians, we recognize that true freedom is found not merely in political liberty but in living as faithful disciples of Jesus Christ. During this month, let us reflect with gratitude on the immense love Christ has shown us and renew our trust in the saving power of His sacrifice.

As many families travel during the summer, I offer a gentle reminder: please do not neglect your Sunday Mass obligation while away from home. Wherever your travels may take you, seek out a local Catholic church and join fellow believers in worship.

I also thank you for your continued generosity and stewardship. Summer months often bring increased parish expenses while regular attendance may decrease. 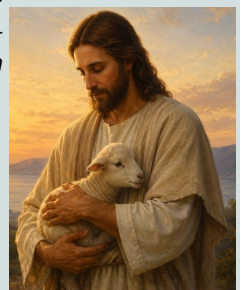

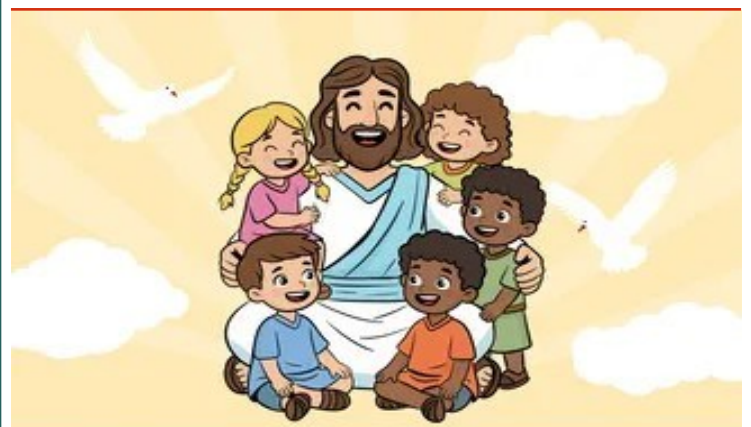
