

Greetings From Father Hector

Dear Friends

When Einstein fled Nazi Germany, he lived near Princeton University. A ten-year-old girl named Emmy, who was having issues with math heard about him and visited him frequently. When Emmy's mother heard about it, she was horrified and told her that since he was a very important man, she should not be bothering him. Her mother went to apologize to Einstein but he cut her off saying, "She has not been bothering me! When a child finds such joy in learning, then it is my joy to help her learn! Please don't stop Emmy from coming to me with her math problems. She is welcome here anytime." —And that is how it is with God! He wants us to come to His house anytime!

The lawyer had asked, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus did not answer his query but told him to be a good neighbor: "Go and do likewise." Jesus does not tell us what to do but rather invites us to change our attitudes and thinking regarding others. It is a call to conversion, a call to create a welcoming and open heart that excludes no one, because in loving our neighbor we are loving God. Who do we see as neighbors? Generally, we like to think of neighbors as the people of our "kind", our faith, our community, our color, and our social class.

This week challenges us to think that our neighbor might be someone totally different. We might not consider him/her deserving of our time, concern and care and yet he/she is the person who is the neighbor we are called to love.

Queridos amigos,

Al huir de Alemania nazi, se estableció cerca de la Universidad de Princeton en Estados Unidos. Una niña de diez años llamada Emmy, que tenía problemas con la matemática, oyó hablar de él y lo visitaba con frecuencia. Al enterarse, la madre de Emmy se horrorizó y le dijo que, como era un hombre muy importante, no debía molestarlo. Su madre fue a disculparse con Einstein, pero él la interrumpió diciendo: "¡No me ha estado molestando! Cuando una niña encuentra tanta alegría en aprender, ¡es mi alegría ayudarla a aprender! Por favor, no le impidas a Emmy que venga a mí con sus problemas de matemática. Es bienvenida aquí en cualquier momento". ¡Y así es con Dios! ¡Él quiere que vayamos a su casa en cualquier momento!

El abogado había preguntado: "¿Quién es mi prójimo?". Jesús no le respondió, sino que le dijo que fuera un buen prójimo: "Ve y haz tú lo mismo". Jesús no nos dice qué hacer, sino que nos invita a cambiar nuestra actitud y nuestra manera de pensar respecto a los demás. Es un llamado a la conversión, un llamado a crear un corazón acogedor y abierto que no excluya a nadie, porque al amar al prójimo amamos a Dios. ¿A quiénes consideramos prójimos? Generalmente, nos gusta pensar en el prójimo como personas de nuestra misma categoría, nuestra fe, nuestra comunidad, nuestro color y nuestra clase social.

Esta semana nos reta a pensar que nuestro prójimo podría ser alguien totalmente diferente. Quizás no lo consideremos merecedor de nuestro tiempo, preocupación y cuidado, y sin embargo, es el prójimo al que estamos llamados a amar. Jesús nos dice a nosotros, "Anda y haz tú lo mismo".


Are you married civilly and wanting to get married in the church? If so, come to an informational meeting to find out how to make yours a "sacramental" marriage!


