**ALTAR SOCIETY ANNUAL FINANCES:** Thank you to all the ladies of the parish for your support of our church and community in many ways. During fiscal year July 1, 2024-June 30, 2025 the largest income items were the semi-annual rummage sales (\$3,120), followed by \$2,324.94 in net funeral dinner income and \$1,900 in dues from ladies of the parish. Expenses incurred were \$142.56 for bills directly paid to vendors for liturgical supplies (Easter candle, altar candles, palms, altar wine, baptismal garments, altar bread, pew missalettes and music issues, etc.). \$6,500 in profits was given to the parish to reimburse for the liturgical expenses when the Altar Society did not have adequate timely cash flow.
