Memorial Chimes Given to All Saints Church and Eben Ezer

The Griffin chimes are in memory of Neil Wahler and Bonnie Kent, who were faithful in their love of the Lord and remembered by those who loved them during their earthly walk with a financial gift to All Saints Church.

Griffin chimes are made for outdoor enjoyment from aluminum that produces warm, rich, full tones that resonate for up to five seconds. The chimes do not require anyone to be an accomplished musician as the mallet strikes allow anyone who picks it up to "paint with sound" on the chimes, creating beautiful music. Yet, accomplished musicians were heard playing "Amazing Grace" and "Jesus Loves Me" with those gathered singing, the day of the dedication. A wheelchair can easily become a comfortable piano bench.

Neil, an accomplished organist, played the All Saints Church Moeller pipe organ on special occasions and some Sundays before moving to Eben Ezer assisted living. He was a faithful attender at Sunday morning worship and Friday Bible study.

Bonnie was a member of All Saints Church and faithful attender of Friday Bible study. She loved the opportunity of traveling to the Holy Land and walking where Jesus walked before she moved to Eben Ezer. All Saints Church was named in Bonnie's estate with a gift for the ministry to neighbors.

The Griffin chimes are for all neighbors, staff, and families' enjoyment that we might be touched at the heart of our spirit with God's love, plus God receives the glory with every beautiful tone!


