KAMICARE - AI FALL DETECTION

DETECT AND RESPOND TO FALLS FASTER

We utilize the KamiCare system to pinpoint what caused a neighbor to fall. When we are able to see what caused the fall, we can implement a meaningful intervention to prevent future falls. – Krystal Ginther, Nursing Home Administrator

I've enjoyed using the KamiCare system, especially on the memory care neighborhood and for other neighbors who have significant memory conditions. Those neighbors often can't recall any details surrounding a fall. KamiCare has helped us dive deep into any predisposing environmental or health status causative factors of the fall, along with any patterns (day or time of day) when the neighbor tends to fall. I never knew this type of technology existed before coming to Eben Ezer! It truly has helped make interventions more person-centered!

When a neighbor, Elizabeth, moved from Assisted Living to skilled nursing, KamiCare was implemented. The team investigated the video footage to determine the root cause of her falls. The team was able to see what she was doing prior to falling. This allowed adjustments to be made in her room. These adjustments included reorganizing her bathroom cabinet and removing extra items and rugs from her room.

These interventions helped prevent future falls by understanding, through KamiCare, what her normal patterns of movements are before a fall. KamiCare has been a valuable tool to prevent Elizabeth and others from falling.
