ALL-STUDENT ORIENTATION

Orientation is a meeting that prepares parents and students for the upcoming school year. The K4 through 8th grade student orientation requires the attendance of at least one parent/guardian from the student's immediate family. The 9th through 12th grade student orientation requires at least one parent/guardian from the student's immediate family as well as each student.

If you are unable to attend the orientation meeting, you must make arrangements to meet with your child's teacher before your child begins the school year.

2026-2027 REGISTRATION

- Registration fees once paid are **non-refundable and non-transferable**.
- Registrations made **after June 1**, may require **two months** of tuition payments to accompany the registration fee.
- Registration and tuition payments must be made using **two different checks** – one for registration and one for tuition.

TESTING FEE

- New 1st through 6th grade students are required to take an entrance test.
- The testing fee is \$20.00 cash. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

EXTENDED DAYCARE

- **Extended daycare is available from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.** Your child may be on campus from 8:00 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. (K4 - 8th) or from 7:45 a.m. to 3:45 p.m. (9th - 12th) without any additional charge.
- Students on campus outside of the above times who are not in the daycare program will be charged a rate of up to \$5.00 for each 15-minute interval.

2026-2027 TUITION

- Tuition is an annual fee that may be paid in **ten equal monthly payments**, August 1st through May 1st.
- Monthly payments are due the 1st of each month and are late after the 10th of the month.

OTHER FINANCIAL INFORMATION

- There is approximately a 5% discount for tuition paid in full **no later than 12:00, noon, July 3, 2026**. Contact the school office for the exact amount.
- A **late tuition charge of \$25.00** will be added to the account if the tuition is not received by the 10th of each month.
- **Returned check charge is \$35.00.** If we receive two returned checks, your account will be on a cash only basis. **All returned checks must be paid by cash or cashier's check only.**
- It is necessary to give the school a **minimum of 30 days written notice prior to removal of students**, otherwise forfeiting that month's tuition. A 30-day notice needs to be given for any changes regarding tuition or daycare rates. **One change per account free of charge will be allowed for the school year.** Subsequent changes will be charged a fee of \$10.00 each.
- There is approximately a 5% discount on tuition for the second student in the same immediate family.
- Terminated accounts created by withdrawing a student (provided the school was given a 30-day notice) are pro-rated to the day to ensure that charges are made only for services rendered.
- **Lunch and snack items:** Lunch and snack items are available for purchase from the on-campus 901 Cafe. Menus will be provided at the beginning of the year and posted near the service window.
- **An \$80.00 senior graduation fee** must be paid by each graduating senior by the second Friday in October.
