GLACIER EXPRESS ROUTE

Experience Switzerland’s most legendary train route. A breathtaking ride through the Swiss Alps with a visit to Switzerland’s oldest city and authentic lunch in a mountain village.

Time: 8:30 AM – 6:00 PM
Pace: Moderate, frequent seated travel with light walking
Price range: CHF 375 - 995 (depending on group size and ticket class)

- Travel the legendary Glacier Express route on historic, regional trains
 - See the Rhine Gorge, Oberalp Pass (6560 ft.), and the Schöllenen Gorge
 - Relaxed, authentic lunch and sightseeing in the mountain village of Disentis
 - 1 hour for shopping in Chur



Chur (1 hr)

A short visit to Switzerland’s oldest city for sightseeing and light shopping

Disentis (2hr)

Reserved lunch in an alpine village and time to shop for souvenirs.

Return to Zurich via Göschenen (1h45m)

Unwind on the scenic return trip to Zurich



Rhine Gorge (pass by)

Marvel at the Swiss Grand Canyon, carved by the Rhine River

Oberalp Pass (pass by)

Ascend to 6560 ft. into the Alps to see the source of the Rhine River

NIESEN KULM

Ride a historic funicular up to Niesen, the ‘Swiss Pyramid,’ for panoramic views and a mountaintop meal. A peaceful, scenic day in the Bernese Alps.

Time: 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM

Pace: minimal walking, mostly seated

Price range: CHF 395 - 895 (depending on group size and ticket class)

Highlights:

- Scenic travel around Lake Thun
- Historic funicular ride to the mountain peak
- Lunch at mountaintop restaurant with panoramic views
- Return to Zurich by late afternoon

Train to Spiez (1hr45m)

Ride through Bern and around picturesque Lake Thun

Panoramic lunch and sightseeing (3h15m)

The summit provides an unobstructed 360-degree view of the Bernese Alps, Lake Brienz, and the Jura mountains

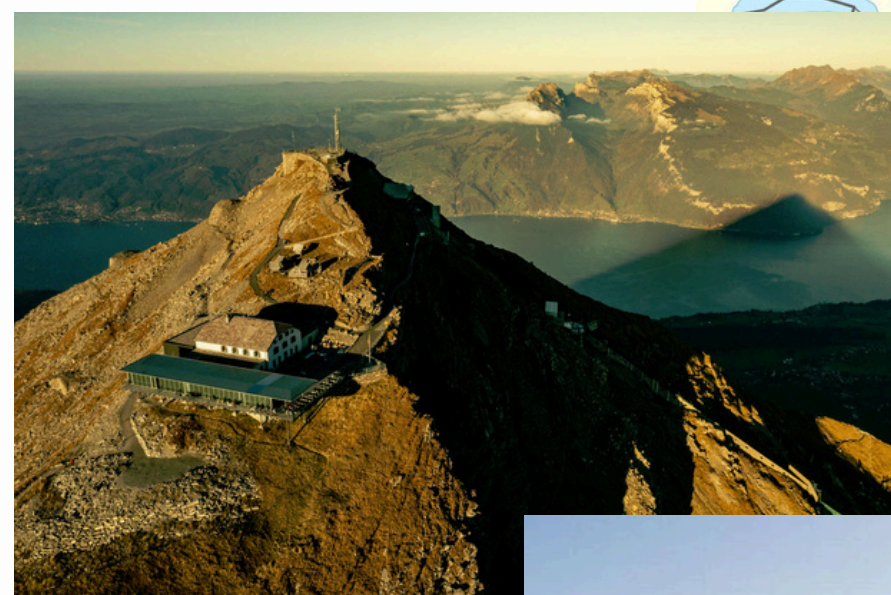


Funicular to Niesen Kulm (30m)

The Niesenbahn carries passengers to the summit, with a 66% incline at its maximum

Return to Zurich via Bern (2h45m)

After a full day making memories that will last a lifetime, pass through the “capitol” city of Bern.



LAUTERBRUNNEN

Visit one of Switzerland’s most iconic valleys, framed by cliffs and waterfalls.

Time: 9:00 AM – 6:00 PM

Pace: Relaxed

Price range: CHF 375 - 995 (depending on group size and ticket class)

Highlights:

- Breathtaking views from the train
- Waterfalls, chalets, and alpine charm in a fairy tale village
- 4 hours in Lauterbrunnen, plenty of time for an authentic lunch and shopping
- 30 minutes for photos in Interlaken



Interlaken (30m)

A short photo stop in the picturesque village at the foot of the Swiss Alps

Lauterbrunnen (4hr)

After dining at an authentic Swiss restaurant, explore the quaint village for shopping and sightseeing.



Train to Interlaken (2hr)

Stunning views as the train heads into the Bernese Oberland

Train to Lauterbrunnen (30m)

A regional train deep into the mountain valley. Upon arrival, view the stunning Staubbachfall.

Return to Zurich via Bern (2h30m)

After a full day making memories that will last a lifetime, pass through the “capitol” city of Bern.

SPIEZ & INTERLAKEN

With its historic castle and beautiful lakeside vineyards, Spiez offers a unique blend of natural beauty and culture without the crowds.

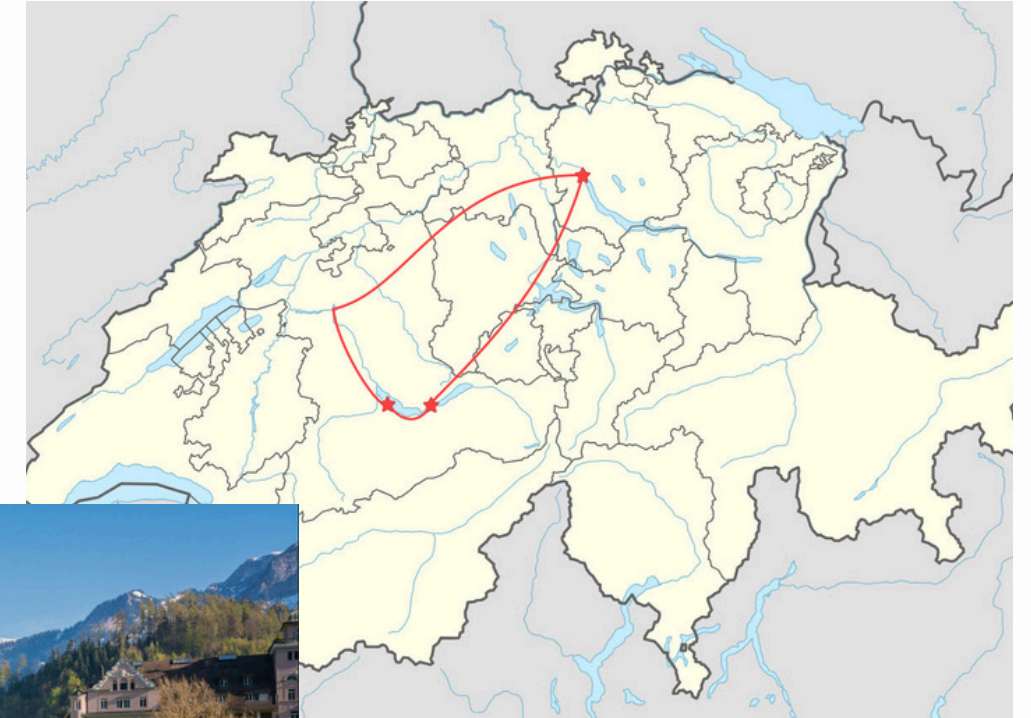
Time: 8:30 AM – 6:00 PM
