
Do You Really Need a Laptop?

Choosing a Chromebook or a tablet over a traditional laptop comes down to your needs. Tablet (iPad or Android Tablet)

Password Book vs. Manager

A password manager is the recommended method for password storage because of security and convenience. They store all credentials in an encrypted digital vault, which is unlocked by a single, strong Master Password and protected by Multi-Factor Authentication. This makes it easy to create and use unique, complex passwords for each online account, reducing the risk that a breach on one site affects others.

A password book provides physical security (protection from cyber threats) but is prone to loss or damage, out of date passwords, and often encourages users to choose shorter, weaker passwords because they have to be manually written down and typed in every time.

In short, while a password book removes the risk of a digital hack, a password manager eliminates the much greater risk of password reuse and human error.

VPN Explained

A VPN (Virtual Private Network) is a powerful privacy tool that encrypts your data end-to-end. This turns all your online activity into scrambled code so that hackers, advertisers, and your internet provider can't read it. Public Wi-Fi at airports, hotels, or coffee shops? A hacker's playground. A VPN locks down your connection, even on unsecured networks

What a VPN does NOT do:

"I'm completely anonymous."

False. A VPN hides where you are (your IP address), but websites still know who you are via cookies, account logins, and browser fingerprinting. You must combine it with other good habits.

"I'm protected from viruses."

False. A VPN secures your connection, especially on public Wi-Fi, but it is not an anti-malware shield. You still need antivirus software and must be careful about which links you click.

"Free VPNs are just as good."

False. Free services often log and sell your data, use weak security, or inject ads to profit from your usage. A legitimate VPN relies on paid subscriptions.

Open Enrollment - Medicare Won't Call You

Medicare will never call you unless you call them first. Here's how to tell if you're talking to a scammer:

- They ask for personal information.
- They pressure you into making a decision.
- They try to offer you a special deal.
- You see a suspicious caller ID number.

As soon as you suspect the call is a scam, hang up. Do not provide the scammer with any of your personal information or confirm any information they request.



Protect Yourself from Banking Scams!

Boost your bank account security:

- Enable Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA). This prevents unauthorized access if your password is stolen.
- Use a strong, unique password that you have never used for any other account.
- Keep your operating systems, browsers, and devices fully updated to close security gaps.
- Make sure you have trusted antivirus software running on your computer.
- Monitor your account activity regularly.

Write safer checks:

- User permanent ink gel pens.
- Avoid blank spots on your check. For Example, a horizontal line after the written check amount.
- Put checks in the mail at the Post Office.
- Use online bill pay instead of checks to pay bills.
