

WORLD SERIES PITCHING FORMAT

9u-12u Pitching Rules

A Pitcher may not exceed more than 18 outs in a single day or 27 outs in back-to-back days. Violation of this rule will be an ejection of the pitcher that exceeded the pitch limit and ejection of the head coach in the game which the pitch limit was violated in. The game will resume.

A pitcher who pitches two consecutive days, must sit out one day from the pitching position regardless of if the 27 out limit was reached.

If a pitcher takes a day's rest, the 27 outs have been reset.

A pitcher removed from the pitching position cannot return to the pitching position during a game but can re-enter to any other position.

Pitchers may not wear on either hand, wrist bands, batting gloves, or arm sleeves, regardless of color or style. A pitch communication device is the only exception.

Pitchers may wear prescription glasses. All other eyewear is left up to the umpire's discretion.

13u Pitching Rules

A Pitcher may not exceed more than 21 outs in a single day or 30 outs in back-to-back days. Violation of this rule will be an ejection of the pitcher that exceeded the pitch limit and ejection of the head coach in the game which the pitch limit was violated in. The game will resume.

A pitcher who pitches two consecutive days must sit out one day from the pitching position regardless of if the 30 out limit was reached.

If a pitcher takes a day's rest, the 30 outs have been reset.

A pitcher removed from the pitching position cannot return to the pitching position during a game but can re-enter to any other position.

Pitchers may not wear on either hand, wrist bands, batting gloves, or arm sleeves, regardless of color or style. A pitch communication device is the only exception.

Pitchers may wear prescription glasses. All other eyewear is left up to the umpire's discretion.

14u Pitching Rules

No pitch limits are implemented in the 14u Division
