Aurora's outreach team began working with a woman experiencing chronic homelessness, mental health challenges, substance use struggles, and repeated involvement with the justice system. After verifying her homelessness status, the team assessed her, and she was added to the coordinated entry prioritization list. Despite significant setbacks, including a serious accident requiring surgery, the client remained committed to changing her life. Aurora supported her in completing the paperwork required for housing and reconnecting with her primary care doctor. Through ongoing advocacy and consistent support, this client now has a stable place to call home.

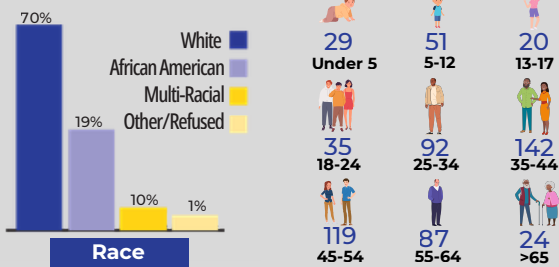

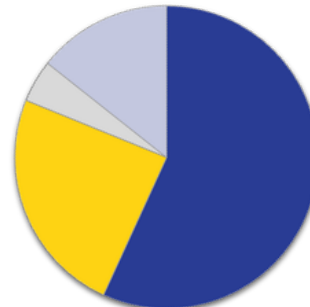
