Through collaborative and hands-on activities, campers will build, craft, and play in ways that spark imagination, curiosity, and teamwork. Every day encourages self-expression, problem-solving, and joyful exploration, leaving children inspired and proud of their inventive creations.

Little Gardeners

Get ready for hands-on exploration, outdoor fun, time in MSE's garden and greenhouse, and getting delightfully messy! Children will dig, plant, water, and care for living things while learning about seeds, soil, roots, worms, composting, plant growth, and the wonders of gardening. Through sensory exploration and creative garden projects, campers will discover how plants grow, thrive, and support the world around them, leaving them inspired, curious, and garden-curious.

Movers & Groovers

Come learn about rhythm, movement, and joyful expression! Campers will explore music through singing, dancing, and learning about instruments. They'll move their bodies in fun dances, participate in relay races and obstacle courses, and enjoy a special dance class at a real dance studio at MSE's neighbor, Evergreen School of Ballet. Kids will have a blast moving, grooving, and playing freely, and showcasing a mini-performance at the end of the week!

Passport to the World

Bonjour! Hola! Hatujambo! Each day, campers will explore a different continent and travel to countries within it, learning about culture, language, food, art, music, traditions, animals, and stories. They'll have fun "boarding a plane" with passports as they journey to new destinations together. Guest visitors will join to teach about different cultures and traditions from their home countries, adding even more hands-on learning and global connection that introduce them to the world and engage them in new cultures!

Eco-Creators!

Older campers will take upcycling to the next level, experimenting with larger-scale projects, mixed media, and more complex construction techniques. They'll collaborate on inventive sculptures, functional art, and creative structures, putting their problem-solving and design skills to the test. Throughout the week, campers explore creativity, teamwork, and resourcefulness, discovering how discarded materials can become extraordinary art. Students will leave feeling proud of their innovative creations and inspired to see the potential in everyday objects.

Green Thumb Club

School-aged campers will explore seeds, soil, composting, and plant growth while taking on larger, hands-on projects like greenhouse work, building garden kits, creating fairy habitats and terrariums, and designing outdoor plant installations. They'll get their hands dirty, experiment with water, soil, and natural materials, and take pride in seeing their projects come to life. By the end of the week, campers will leave inspired, knowledgeable, and equipped with skills to continue growing their own garden and green spaces.

Trailhead Trekkers

MSE is surrounded by amazing hiking trails, and campers will spend each morning exploring them! They'll hike local paths, discover hidden spots in nature, observe plants and wildlife, and play in nature's own backyard. After lunch, students will return to campus to spark their curiosity and creativity with hands-on, nature-inspired projects and activities. With plenty of free play, adventure, and collaborative projects, kids will experience the thrill of the outdoors, build confidence on the trails, and develop a deeper connection to the natural world.

World Culture Studio

Campers will take an immersive journey across continents through hands-on cultural experiences. Throughout the week, campers will cook food (such as paella and sushi), explore different art forms, and learn about beautiful traditions from around the world. Guest visitors from different countries will join and share personal stories and customs from their home country. This engaging camp experience expands campers' understanding of the world while encouraging creativity, curiosity, and a genuine appreciation for global cultures.
