

## From the Nurse's Office



### Reminders:

- It is mandatory to fill out your child's Physical Examination Form (by a doctor) and First Aid Waiver for the 2026-2027 Academic Year. (Both forms are enclosed in this Welcome Package). New students who just submitted these documents for admission do not have to submit new ones.
- Vaccines – According to PR Law 25 of September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 1983, no student may be allowed on school premises until he/she hands an up-to-date Vaccination Certificate approved by the PR Health Department (PVAC-3 Form):
  - If your child was vaccinated during the summer, please remember to bring the updated vaccination form.
- Oral Exam Certification (Enclosed) – As required by PR law, an oral examination certification from your child's dentist must be handed in to the school nurse for each even numbered grade student (Kinder, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> graders)
- Do not bring your child to school if he/she shows any of the following symptoms:

Fever	Cough	Sore throat
Nasal congestion	Body ache	Headache
Chills	Vomiting	Diarrhea

- If your child develops any of these symptoms at school, you will be contacted to pick up your child right away.
- Finally, remember that if your child is going to be absent due to illness or any other medical reason, you will need to excuse them via email.
