SESO Dress Code



School Uniform

The School Uniform must be clean and neat, without visible holes nor tears.

Preschool and Elementary School: PK - 5th Grade:

- Official SESO polo shirt or PE shirt, hoodie, or zipper sweater.
- Dark blue skorts, knee-length, bermuda-pants, long pants, or School Physical Education pants.
- Socks and closed footwear (dress or tennis shoe) in good condition.

High School: 6th – 12th Grade:

- Any official SESO polo shirt or Class, Club or event shirt, hoodie, or sweater.
- ➤ Dark blue, knee-length, bermuda-pants, long pants, or school's official Physical Education long or basketball style short pants. (No skirts a/o skorts)
- Socks and closed footwear (dress or tennis shoe) in good condition.
- > 12th Grade students may wear casual attire on Fridays, as a privilege which may be revoked.

Physical Education Uniform:

- > On PE Days, students must wear a Physical Education T-shirt and official navy-blue long or basketball style pants with school emblem.
- This uniform is mandatory on Physical Education days. (We strongly recommend that High school students bring an additional Gym shirt to change after class.)

Casual Days:

- SESO students are expected to dress neatly, and wear age-appropriate garments.
- > If students have Physical Education, they should wear appropriate clothing and sneakers.
- All tops must cover shoulders, midriff, backs, and cleavage.
- ➤ All shoes should be closed—toe shoes.
- ➤ The following clothing and footwear are prohibited: strapless, "spaghetti" strap shirts, low-riding jeans/ pants, pajamas, clothes made from transparent fabrics, clothes with socially offensive, alcohol or drug-related themes, clothes with offensive advertising, lewd printing or pictures, or political propaganda.
