

OCCUPATIONAL SKILLS PROGRAMME: INCIDENT INVESTIGATION TEAM MEMBER



The Incident Investigation Team Member Skills Programme equips learners with the knowledge and practical skills required to participate effectively in workplace incident and accident investigations. The programme focuses on identifying causes of incidents, gathering and analysing evidence, contributing to investigation reports and supporting corrective actions aimed at preventing future occurrences. It is designed to strengthen workplace health and safety systems through effective incident investigation practices.

This programme is ideal for Occupational Health and Safety Representatives, supervisors, team leaders, employees, safety committee members and other workplace role players who may be required to participate in incident or accident investigations. Learners develop the ability to contribute objectively and professionally to investigation teams while complying with legal and organisational requirements.

The programme is designed to develop competencies in:

- Understanding workplace incident and accident investigation principles
- Identifying different types of workplace incidents and accidents
- Applying incident investigation methodologies and techniques
- Gathering and preserving evidence from incident scenes
- Conducting witness interviews and collecting information
- Assisting with root cause analysis activities
- Contributing to incident investigation reports
- Recommending corrective and preventative actions
- Applying legal and regulatory requirements relating to incident investigations
- Supporting organisational health and safety improvement initiatives
