

SCHEDULE

Class 1 NOVICE CUBHUNTER TEAM CHASE

Entry fee £140 per team*

Fixed fences up to approx. 3', suitable for all ages

To be judged by a bogey time

Prizes to 3rd place, rosettes to 10th place

Spillers Team Trials Challenge Cup for best Bicester & Whaddon Team.

Eligibility is restricted to the Bicester Hunt with Whaddon Chase, Bicester & Warden Hill and Whaddon Chase Pony Clubs.

Eligibility for all prizes should be indicated when entering

Please ensure you have fully compliant safety equipment. Inspections of hat tags and body protectors will take place.

Class 2 OPEN TEAM CHASE

Entry fee £170 per team*

* Entry price includes Paramedic Fees.

Prize Fund: 1st £400 2nd £250 3rd £150 4th £100 *Special prize for non TB team (min 3 non TB's in the team)*

This event is a qualifier for the 2026 National Championship. Riders must be 16 years or over and horses must be 14.2hh or over.

All competitors to provide their own number bibs and we will provide number inserts. A small number of bibs will be available to purchase from the secretary's lorry on the day.

Class 3 INTERMEDIATE SPEED TEAM CHASE

Entry fee £160 per team*

Prize Fund: 1st £200 2nd £140 3rd £80 4th £40

Intermediate Speed Team Chase: Maximum height of fixed fences approx. 3'6".

To be judged against the clock.

Riders must be 16 years of age or over; horses must be 14.2hh or over.

Class 4 INTERMEDIATE BOGEY TEAM CHASE

Entry fee £160 per team*

Prizes in kind to 3rd place, rosettes to 10th place

Intermediate Bogey Team Chase: Maximum height of fixed fences approx. 3'3". To be judged against a bogey time. Riders must be 14 years of age or over or by application. Horses must be 14.2hh or over. The course is a mixture of the larger novice fences and smaller intermediate speed class fences making for an ideal first time intermediate course.

Entries open Saturday 7th February 2026

RULES

The team chase classes are run under the auspices of the BHSA governing body and are bound by their rules. These may be found [here](#). It is a requirement that all participants carry Third Party insurance for not less than £5m - **this is now included with your BTC Membership**. It is also strongly recommended that all participants have Personal Accident Insurance

Rider Safety Wear Rules:

1. Hat standards – Hats will be identified by a BTC, BE, PC or BRC approved Hat Tag. **Only the following hat standards will be accepted: British and European PAS 015 (2011) or VG01 040 2014-12** – both with a BSI Kitemark or Inspect IC Mark; American ASTM F1163 2004a onwards with SEI mark, Snell 2016 or 2021 (no other mark is needed with Snell) or Australia and New Zealand AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards with SAI Global mark.
2. Body Protectors – All competitors must also wear a body protector **British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) 2018 Level 3 standard (blue and black label)**. A body protector of this nature is also required when competitors are wearing air jackets of any make. **The BETA 2018 label will be the only accepted standard.**

Disclaimer of Liability

Neither the landowners, organisers nor any of their representatives accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, ponies, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, contents or accessories or any other person whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence or in any other way.

Cancellation Policy

In the event of cancellation 75% of entry monies to be refunded if the cancellation occurs prior to the close of entries, 50% of entry monies to be refunded if the event is cancelled after the close of entries and up until 48 hours before the event and 25% of entry monies to be refunded if the event is cancelled 48 hours or less prior to the event.
