Course: To be run over the novice team chase course

Approx. 1.5 miles with approx. 21 fences including a Pen, max. fixed approx. 100cm winners will be judged on an optimum time set at a fair hunting pace. All riders under the age of 12 must have a riding

reference from a MFH or the DC of a pony club.

CLASS 2. Intermediate Team Chase (Fastest Time)

Course: Approx. 1.75 miles with approx. 23 fences including a Pen, max. fixed height approx. 110cm.

All riders must be 16yo or over.

Any amendments to entries, including team/rider/horse names must be done at www.teamchasingreg.co.uk or on the day of the event. Any issues with times must be emailed to the secretary 48hrs prior to the event or they may not be able to be dealt with.

This competition is run under British Team Chasing Rules as published at www.britishteamchasing.co.uk/rider-guidance please make sure that you read all of the rules very carefully before the event.

It is a requirement that all participants carry third party insurance for not less than £5m.

Riders will be held responsible for adhering to any rule affecting themselves or their horses. Particular attention should be paid to safety and protection, age of and horse welfare, abuse of horses & exchanging horses. It is strongly recommended that all participants have Personal Accident Insurance.

CLASS 1 Results will be judged on faults and a Optimum time set at a fair hunting pace.

CLASS 4 Results will be judged on a optimum time set at a fair hunting pace (circa 425-475m/min).

CLASS 2, 3 & 4 Teams must consist of 3 or 4 riders. Results will be judged on the time of the third horse through the finish, this will be the time for the team.

CLASS 2 & 3 Results will be judged on fastest time.

General Rules:

No horse or pony may compete more than once in each class, the only exception is under rule 8g in the BTC Rulebook.

The organisers reserve the right to return or refuse any entry.

The organisers and the landowners do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, grooms, spectators or any person or property whatever on the ground. All vehicles are parked at the owner's risk. No responsibility can be accepted for damage to or loss from those vehicles moving or parking on the premises.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

Numbers must be collected from the secretaries on the day when declaring your entry. Number bibs must be supplied by competitors.

Competitors shall report to the Collecting Ring Steward 15 minutes before their start time.

The organisers reserve the right to withhold any prizes because of insufficient declared entries, alter the advertised times, eliminate any competitor not adhering to the rules.

In the event of a dispute, the chief steward's decision is final. Any competitor wishing to lodge an objection must first deposit £40 with the event secretary and make their objection in writing. If upheld, the deposit will be refunded.

Veterinary surgeons and farriers will be on the field during the competition and competitors will be required to pay in full for any services received.

If the event is cancelled the following policy will be adhered to:

75% of entry monies to be refunded if the event is cancelled prior to the close of entries. 50% of entry monies to be refunded if the event is cancelled after the close of entries and up until 48 hours before the event. 25% of entry monies to be refunded if the event is cancelled 48 hours or less to the event.
