

Vaccine Policy

(updated 12/01/2025)

It's important for our practice to maintain a consistent vaccine policy. We follow the recommendations from the American Academy of Pediatrics. We firmly believe in the effectiveness of vaccines to prevent serious illness and to save lives, therefore we **Recommend** our patients to receive vaccines recommended by the State of Florida. These include DTaP, IPV, Hib, PCV, Hep B, MMR, Varivax, MCV, TdaP.

REQUIREMENTS:

- **Baby vaccines need to be started by 6 months of age and completed by 24 months of age to be in compliance with our vaccine policy.**
- **Kindergarten vaccines must be received by age 6 as required for entering kindergarten.**
- **7th grade required vaccines must be completed by age 12.**

If you choose an alternative schedule, this "schedule" must be written, signed and agreed upon with the doctor in a contract.

Our routine vaccine schedule does include other vaccines that we recommend, but are not state mandated such as: Rotavirus, Hep-A, HPV, Men B, Flu, and COVID. Our schedule can be found on our website.
