The Wuhan campus is the 2nd oldest of the Maple Leaf Schools and has seen thousands of students successfully graduate and move on to top universities around the world.

The school opened its doors in 2007 with our international high school which runs a grade 10-12 programme along with a K-9 Foreign Nationals School. The schools were very successful and in the following years an elementary school, middle school and Chinese curriculum high school were also added to the campus. There are currently around 600 students in the high school with close to 3,000 students on the campus overall.
