
"Wisdom" Activity

With the gift of Wisdom, think deeply about a situation, conflict, or experience in your life by trying to see things the way God sees them. It could be in the past, present or future. How does you reflection call you to act in the future?



"Understanding" Activity

Think about some people that have been or are in your life now. How can you use the gift of Understanding to help you be more compassionate and aware of those people God has put in your life.



"Knowledge" Activity

Think about a situation that you have come across and jumped to a judgment before knowing all the facts. Now allow the gift of Knowledge to flow in and through you how would you approach this situation or similar situations in the future?



"Counsel" Activity

Think of a time when you had to decide between something right or wrong (e.g., gossiping, standing up for someone or a belief when it's unpopular). How can you make sure to utilize the gift of Counsel / Right Judgment to make the right decision.



"Fortitude" Activity

Take a moment and be honest in letting God know your fears in allowing the Spirit's gift of Courage to empower you in situations that challenge you to stand up for your faith.



"Piety" Activity

Think about someone in your life the has a deep sense of reverence for God, and leads a life of devotion. How can you become more like them? What can you change in your life to be more devoted to God?



(Wonder and Awe)

"Fear of the Lord" Activity

Put in your own words what you will do to trust more in God and all God's wonderous gifts he gives to you each day so that you can live more consistently in the awe and wonder of God's goodness in your life.
