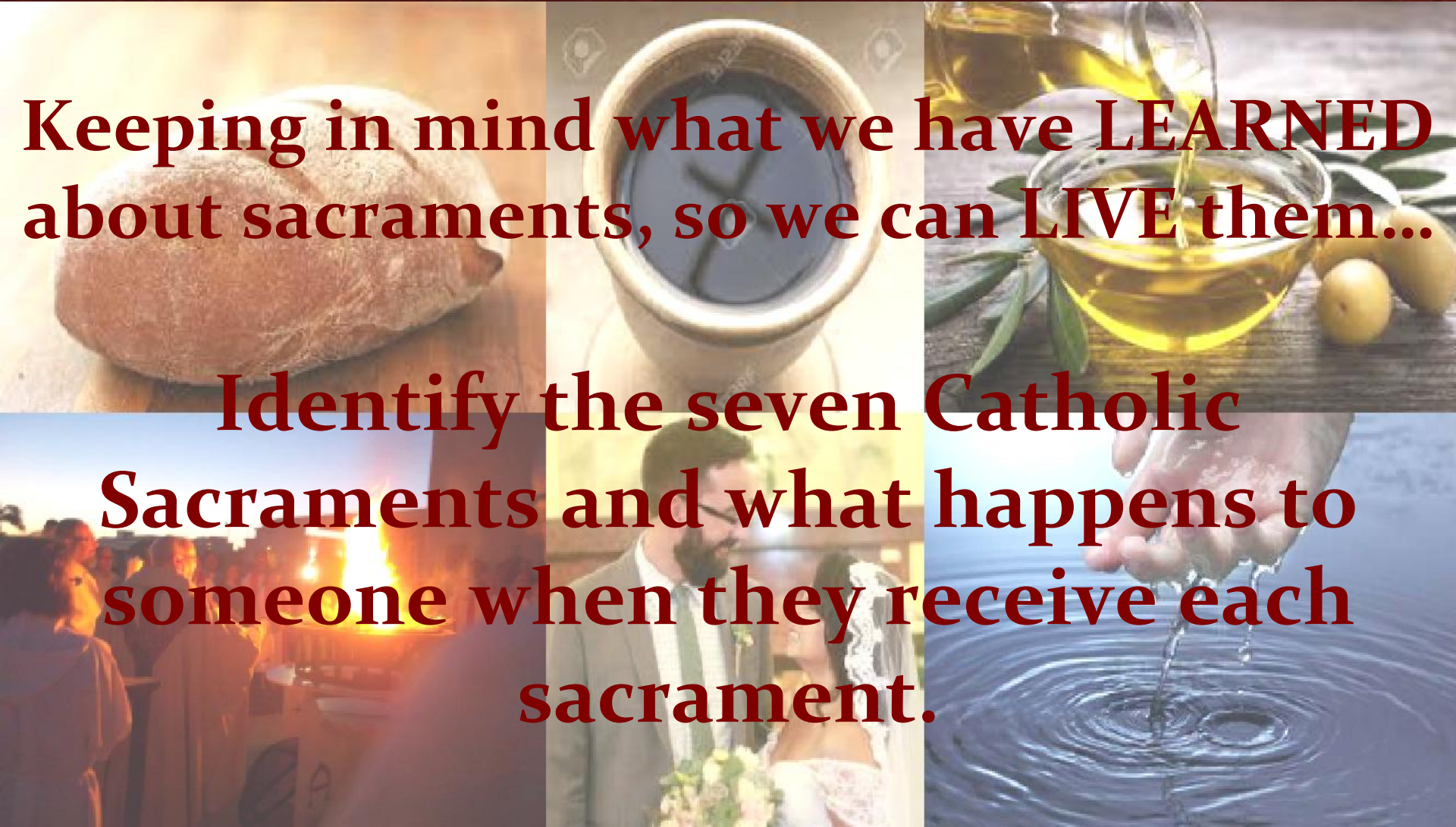

Types of Sacraments

“Initiation”

- Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist



“Healing”

- Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick (and Eucharist)



“Vocation / Mission”

- Matrimony and Holy Orders (and Eucharist)



Matter & Form

Matter: physical substance or actions.

Form: sacred words spoken by the minister

Put It All Together

* Baptism: Matter: Water

Form: I baptize you in the name of the
Father and the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

* Confirmation: Matter: Sacred Chrism Oil

Form: Be sealed with the Holy Spirit.

* Eucharist: Matter: Bread and Wine

Form: Words of Consecration spoken by
the priest.

Put It All Together

* Reconciliation:

Matter: The Person's sins, and their contrition.

Form: Words of Absolution

* Anointing of the Sick:

Matter: Oil of the Sick

Form: Through this holy anointing may
the lord in his love and mercy help you with
the grace of the Holy Spirit.

Put It All Together

* Matrimony:

Matter: Mutual Consent to Marry

Form: Vows by the Couple

* Holy Orders

Matter: Sacred Chrism and Laying of Hands by the Bishop

Form: Prayer of Consecration Prayer
