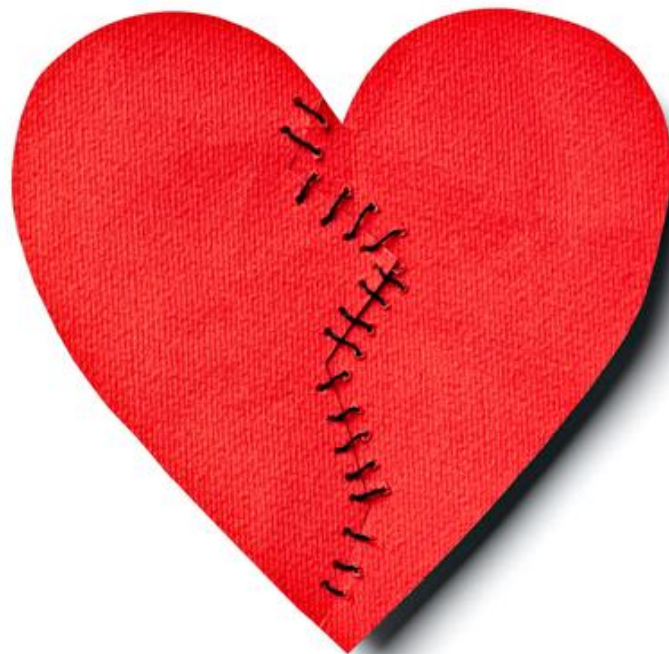

- Baptism, Confirmation and **Eucharist**



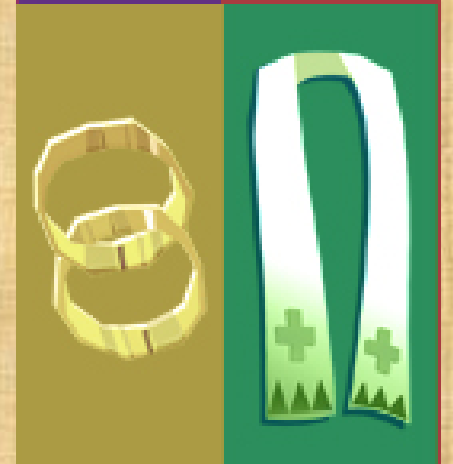
“Healing”

“Mission”

- Matrimony and Holy Orders (and Eucharist)



THE GREATEST COMMANDMENT

“Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?”

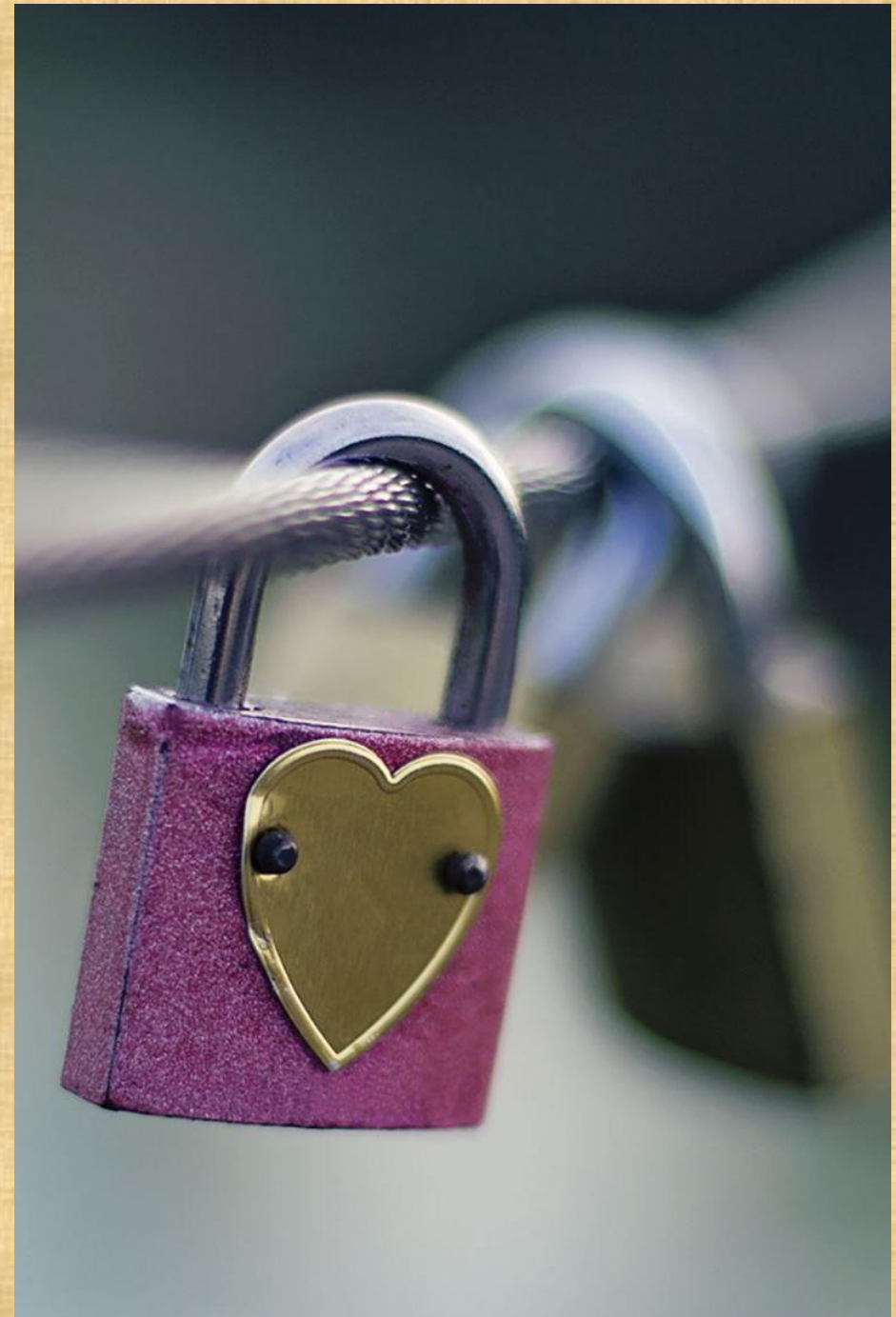
He said to him, *“You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.”*

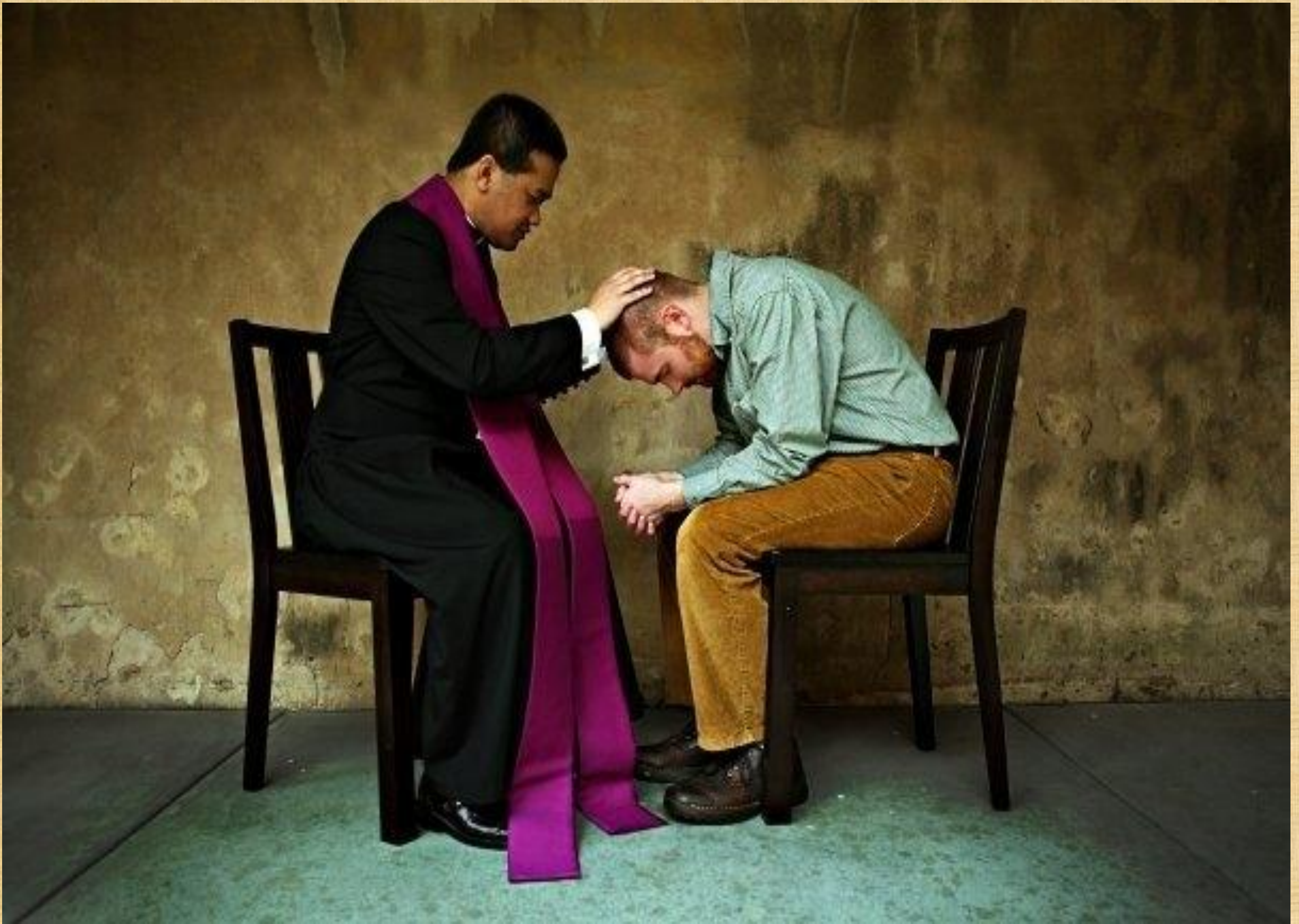

2. Confession to a priest

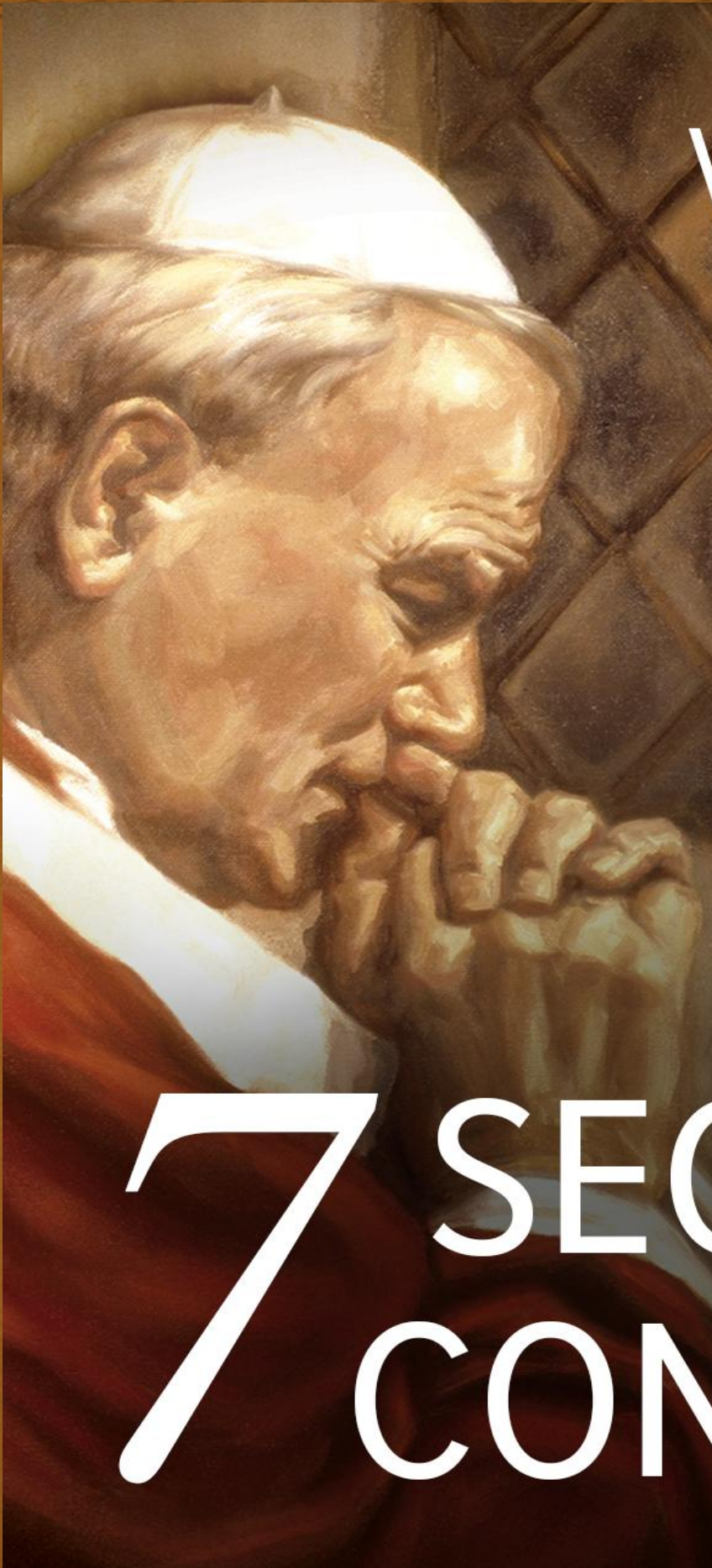
3. Penance

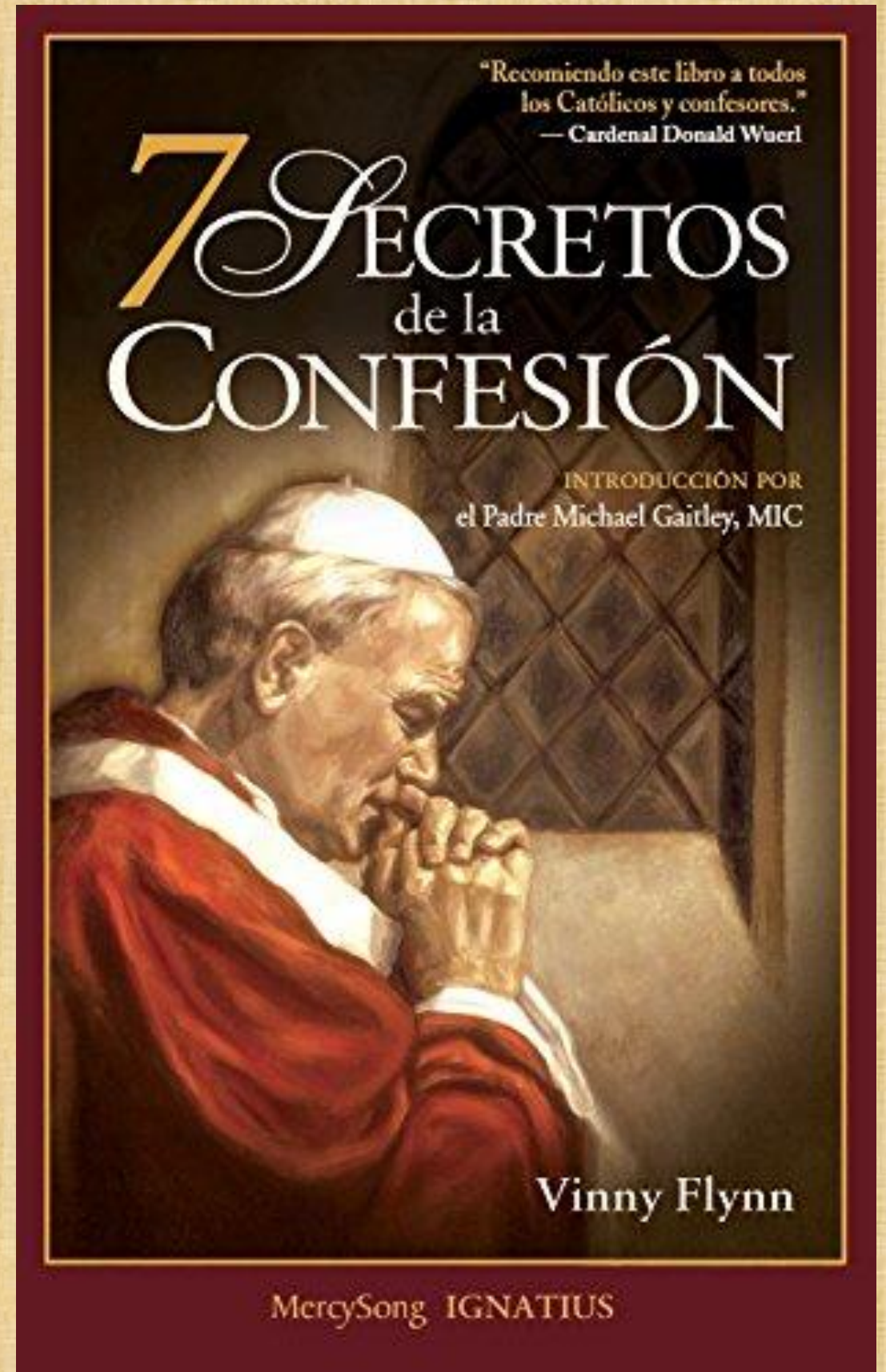
