- Cycle C = Luke






END: Ash Wednesday, Mar. 4

CATHOLICISME



- Advent = Jesus is Coming
- Christmas = Jesus is born
- Ordinary Time = Jesus teaches
  - Lent = Jesus prepares to die
- Easter Triduum = Jesus eats one last meal with his friends, is crucified, & dies
  - Easter = Jesus rises from the dead
